2. Why is evangelism important? What happens without it?
3. How do we hold together the tension of speaking out God's Word and living it as well?
4. Why are speaking the Word and living the Word both so important?

Read 1 Peter 3:13-16

5. What is the difference between making a decision and being continually transformed as you live your life? How does this impact on how you would share with others?
6. How ready are you to "give and answer" for the hope that you have?
7. What is the hope that you have? How would articulate this hope?
8. How would share the hope that you have with others?
9. Have you ever shared (y)our story with others? What was it like? What happened?
10. What do you think are the key parts of the story that you would choose to highlight if you were sharing our story with someone else? Why these bits?
11. How do our four key relationships (God, Self, Each Other, the World) fit into the story that you would tell?
12. Spend some time thinking/discussing/praying together about how you can share our story with others.
