- 1. What is our society's view of marriage? How have society's views on marriage changed during your lifetime?

- 3. "Marriage is a covenant." What does this mean? What is covenantal about it?
- 4. What does keeping the marriage bed pure? How is this done? What happens when this doesn't happen?
- 5. "Not even a hint of immorality." What does this mean? What is sexual immorality? Why is it so destructive?
- 6. What are the consequences of sexual immorality?
- 7. What do you see as the main marriage issue facing the church at the moment? Why?
- 8. What does this verse mean for any pre-marital relationships we might have? What does it mean post-marriage?
- 9. What does this verse, and the stricture against sexual immorality, mean for those who are single?
- 10. What can the church do as a body to help individuals obey verse 5 and avoid the pitfalls of immorality?
