- 4. How is Jesus able to emphathise with us? Why is this important?
- 5. What is the purpose of a high priest?
- 6. What is the significance of Jesus being our high priest? Why does this make a difference?
- 7. How is he different from a normal high priest? How is what he does different? How is this to our benefit?
- 8. What is the relationship between love and power and how does each find its ultimate expression in God?
- 9. What is love without power? How? Why?
- 10. What is power without love? How? Why?
- 11. How do we make sure we continually approach the throne? Why is that notion of 'continually' so important?
- 12. How do you approach the throne of God? What do you find there?
- 13. "Let us approach the throne." What is it important we do this together?
