Read Matthew 7:24-29

- 1. This passage comes at the end of the sermon on the mount. What was Jesus saying in the sermon? What would be your 2-3 sentence summary of it?
- 2. What are the similarities between the two houses? What is the same for both of them in this parable? Why?
- 3. What do the rains and streams and storms represent? What lesson is Jesus teaching in these verses?
- 4. What does this tell us about the type of things he expects to happen in his disciples' lives?
- 5. What does the great crash represent? What will happen to the person who doesn't obey Jesus' words?
- 6. What is the foundation that Jesus is talking about here? What does putting things into practice mean?
- 7. How do we ensure that we have a secure foundation? What helps us maintain it?
- 8. Is it possible to deceive ourselves into thinking we are building on a solid foundation when we are not? How do we guard against this?
- 9. "Following Jesus is not so much about protection *from* trouble but protection *in* trouble." How have you experienced the truth of this in your life?
- 10. What does this tell us about the role we can play in supporting each other in hard times?

Prayer points:

- Continue to pray for the situation in Israel/Palestine and in the Ukraine, and the people affected by these conflicts.
- Pray for the people of Papua New Guinea.
