Read Luke 24:36-49

- 1. What was the first thing Jesus said to the disciples? Why did he say this? What wider application does this have in this context?
- 2. What was the importance of Jesus showing them his hands and feet? What does this tell us about the resurrected Jesus?
- 3. Read verse 45. How has Jesus done this for you?
- 4. What does it mean that we will be Jesus' witnesses?
- 5. Read verse 49. What is this promised gift Jesus said he would send? Why is it important?
- 6. How has the resurrection transformed you? How has Jesus changed you and transformed your life?
- 7. How does Jesus help us see transformation in other people?
- 8. How is this something that is supposed to involve us changing together? Why is that 'together' so important?
- 9. How is Jesus changing your community? How is he calling you to be part of this kingdom transformation?
- 10. How do we hang on to hope in this time between the resurrection and the full, complete transformation of all things?

Prayer points:

- Spend time praying for the situation in Israel/Palestine and the people affected by the conflict.
- Pray for the continuing transformation of your community and your part in this.
- Pray for the recently arrived family from Afghanistan.
