- 4. What aspects of the sacrament of communion are commemorative? Why is it important that we 'remember'?
- 5. How is communion also a celebration? What is it a celebration of? Why is this important?
- 6. Why does Jesus call us 'friends'? What does this mean?
- 7. How does having Jesus as both Lord and friend shape your relationship with him?
- 8. "Remain in me," Jesus said. How do we do this? What rhythms, practices and people help you do this?
- 9. What is significant about the fact that communion was a gift given to the community of God's people? What does this tell us about part of its purpose?
- 10. How to you celebrate communion in your community?
- 11. How could you invite people to share your table over the coming week?
