Read Leviticus 19:33-34

- 4. Why were these verses important? What reason did God give for why they should be followed and obeyed?
- 5. What relevance do all of the above passages have for today?
- 6. What do you know of the current crisis in the Middle East?
- 7. What do you know of the recent history of the area? Why is the area so fraught with tension, bloodshed and controversy?
- 8. What role should followers of Jesus play in this situation?
- 9. How? What can we do from where we are? How can we act effectively and appropriately?
