- 1. Who was John the Baptist? What was his role in the coming of Jesus?
- 2. What was John's reaction to the crowd that came out to see him? Why did he say this?
- 3. What does John tell the people they need to do to live changed lives?
- 4. What things in this passage do we like? What sounds good to us?
- 5. What things in this passage are not so pleasant? What elements of judgement are contained in this passage?
- 6. What is the good fruit that John is talking about? How do our lives produce fruit? How do we ensure the fruit is good?
- 7. What is judgement? What does it mean? What does it look like today?
- 8. What contrasts do we see between John's message and the world of Jesus? Why might there be this difference?
- 9. What message of justice is there in John's message? How does the ministry of Jesus embody this?
- 10. Why is repentance so important? What is repentance?
- 11. What is God calling you to repent of this Advent? How is God calling you to be part of putting things right in the world?
