GLOBAL MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

Kerus Global Education-South Africa Dr. Jennie Cerullo and Dr. Marcia Ball

This year, we celebrate an incredible milestone—25 years of walking in faith, answering God's call, and standing alongside vulnerable children and families worldwide.

In 1995, amid the devastating HIV/AIDS pandemic, God stirred our hearts. As professors of public health and cross-cultural communication committed to our faith, we realized we were uniquely positioned to help. Partnering with organizations like Samaritan's Purse, TWR, CRU, and World Vision, we educated, raised awareness, and mobilized the faith community. By 2000, we resigned from our professorships and launched what would become Kerus Global Education.

From the start, this mission wasn't about us—it was about responding to God's call to be His hands and feet to those suffering through education, compassion, and truth.

We created curricula and training—Life at the Crossroads, It Takes Courage!, and the Grandma's Village audio drama—to teach HIV/AIDS prevention and life skills. These programs have reached communities across Africa, Asia, Europe, North America, and South America with knowledge and hope.

In 2005, in Soshanguve, South Africa, a pastor and teacher showed us grandmothers raising children orphaned by AIDS. This led to the Kerus Care Center, where thousands of children have found safety, love, meals, homework help, and renewed hope.

As the crisis evolved, so did the threats. Once again, God called us to act. Together with partners, we built a safe house for orphaned children and launched the Courage to Care Initiative—training leaders to recognize trauma, respond to trafficking, and protect the vulnerable.

We'll never forget the pastor in Africa who attended this training and later rescued 29 children from trafficking. This is the power of our movement—where knowledge and courage meet, lives are saved.

Thanks to God and your support, we've reached over 6 million people in 65 nations. We've launched training centers, radio programs, the Kerus Care Center, and built church and school partnerships. We've created a community of courageous leaders—pastors, caregivers, and volunteers—empowering the next generation.

As we begin our next 25 years, the world still needs courage, healing, and hope that only Jesus can bring. With your prayers and partnership, we will continue to open doors, serve new children, and celebrate new victories.
