For over 35 years, Haiti Outreach Ministries (HOM) has been sharing the message of God's goodness with the people of Haiti through a holistic approach that addresses spiritual, mental, physical, and economic needs. HOM's thriving ministry operates in the poorest slums of Port-au-Prince. The vision of HOM is to develop self-sustaining communities that help people become the individuals God intended them to be.

The ministry includes three elementary schools, one secondary school, a community health clinic providing medical and dental care, two vocational schools, and three churches. Additionally, HOM provides access to vital clean water through community distribution sites.
