GLOBAL MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

Anna and Patrick Larochelle – Democratic Republic of Congo

The Larochelle family has lived and worked in northeastern Democratic Republic of the Congo since 2015. Patrick is a physician specializing in Internal Medicine and Pediatrics, and Anna is a Family Nurse Practitioner. They have served with Serge as DRC team leaders since 2018.

Their team vision is: "Working together with the Congolese in Jesus' name to heal bodies, spirits, and the social fabric of northeastern Congo, in the hope that we serve as a reminder that God has not forgotten His people in Congo."

Initially, they were sent through the Samaritan's Purse Post-Residency Program to the village of Nyankunde, where they worked at a former mission hospital that was being rebuilt following tribal wars. From 2015 to 2021, they partnered with their Congolese colleagues to train new doctors, teach in the nursing school, and provide specialty consultations.

In 2021, a standoff between the local tribal militia and the Congolese military lasted three days. When the fighting ended, most civilians and missionaries had fled the village.

In early 2022, the Serge team relocated to the nearby city of Bunia. There, Patrick began teaching and mentoring medical students, providing specialty consultations, and working to improve the quality of care at their national partner hospital, CME. Anna has focused primarily on providing medical care for Congolese who have been internally displaced (IDPs) due to ongoing tribal conflict. In partnership with Congolese colleagues, she has helped organize health projects at two IDP camps, offering free medical care to approximately 19,000 displaced people.

The Larochelles hope to continue serving in the DRC as long as God wills. They are grateful to be part of a Serge team on mission for God's glory.
