### Southside Youth Development Our Strategic Vision: 2026-2029

Dear SYD Supporters,

It's hard to believe that what started in 2021 with an abandoned field and a handful of kids has grown into what SYD is today. Because of your support, Southside Youth Development's field has become a community gathering place where each year more than 50 kids in Emma Wheeler Homes and Alton Park have access to a baseball program where they are known, challenged, and encouraged to grow—both on and off the field. Today, we're excited to share our Strategic Vision for 2026–2029.

Our next step is simple: moving from a summer program to year-round youth development. Because the challenges our kids face don't stop when the summer ends—and neither should the support.

#### Where We're Headed:

- **Year-Round Programming:** after-school program launching in Fall 2026, focused on holistic development (academic, social-emotional, spiritual, and athletic development)
- **Expanded Baseball Seasons:** Spring, summer, and fall engagement
- **One-on-One Mentorship:** Connecting youth to consistent, caring adults that are in their corner
- **Leadership Development:** Strengthening our internship program and pathways for older youth to learn professional skills as well as give back to the younger generation.
- **New Experiences:** Continuing to provide college visits, camps, and exposure beyond the neighborhood

This plan isn't just about reaching more kids, but about deepening our impact with the youth through year-round presence—helping instill hope and shape character through the game of baseball.
