Teach Beyond/France

Greetings, Friends and Ministry Partners!

Last week, the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC) entered into a recognized fraternal relationship with the Union Nationale des Églises Protestantes Réformées Évangéliques de France (UNEPREF). This marked the end of eight years of hard work and relationship-building in which Jeff has been engaged. This achievement was made possible by the steady leadership of Stated Clerk Dr. Dean Weaver and the support of COO Johnny Long, along with each of you who have been praying and investing in this work here in France.

Our entire EPC team received an incredibly warm and joyful welcome from all 45 churches of the French denomination. This is more than a formal agreement; it opens a new chapter in our work together, grounded in shared values and a common goal of growing as followers of Jesus Christ.

The goal is to share wisdom and experience as we learn from each other to better serve God's Kingdom. Together, we will train local leaders, including elders and deacons, and develop a team of leaders who will serve as a church health team, enabling their churches to become stronger internally and more outwardly focused as they engage in local missional outreach in the neighborhoods where God is calling them.

This partnership also plans to support new church plants in important cities and send EPC mission staff to work with our French partners on local projects. This past week's work marks the beginning of a new phase in the international relationship between our two denominations, giving us, the EPC, an opportunity to enter more fully into the Gospel story the Lord is writing across France through the lives and communities of our UNEPREF brothers and sisters.

Would you take time to worship the Lord and praise Him for the work of His Spirit in the hearts and lives of people who did not know one another several years ago but who today trust and believe in one another as we move forward in a mutual relationship to see churches strengthened and established in this Gospel-parched land of France?
