For His Children Ecuador

For His Children (FHC) is a Christ-centered ministry that provides residential care for vulnerable children in Ecuador until they can be reunited with their birth families or placed in adoptive homes.

The children in FHC's care have been abandoned, abused, or neglected and are referred by child protective services. FHC serves children with both typical and special needs, ranging in age from newborns to young adults, across two care homes located in Quito and Latacunga.

Each child receives 24-hour, holistic care from loving, well-trained caregivers and staff. This includes therapy, medical attention, education, spiritual nurturing, emotional support, and an abundance of tender, loving care.
