Our Ministry Mission Statement is to serve the needs of our students as they develop their English language skills and to prayerfully foster a community where the truth of God's love and salvation in the Savior, Jesus Christ, can be clearly communicated.

At Hope Clinic, I serve as an office assistant on our medical team that serves the basic medical and spiritual needs of our local refugee community. These needy people come from Sudan, Syria, Iraq, Yemen, and Jordan. At the beginning of each clinic, we gather as a team to pray for the specific needs of our patients and to ask almighty God to provide above and beyond what we could possibly hope for, and to provide His greatest gift of repentance and faith to those whose hearts He has opened.

I thank the Lord for the opportunity to teach English to my students in the Second Circle English Language Program and to practically contribute to their language progress. Our program especially focuses on encouraging our students in their conversational ability, and I think they have improved compared to their level at the start of the year.
