GLOBAL MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

World Outreach EPC
Adger and Sandra McKay
Germany

Adger and Sandra McKay work with World Outreach to serve Syrian refugees in Europe. They are involved in engaging the displaced among refugees in Germany and beyond.

Their ministry statement is to love the person that God puts in front of you and share His truth. They do this by maintaining relationships with refugees to show His heart and love/the gospel, expanding the ministry to include their gifting via training and teaching, as well as trauma counseling.

They work with displaced persons from Afghanistan, Iran, Iraq, Syria, and more who are part of God's great plan for the Diaspora, sharing the Lord's love and truth in manifold ways. They are also involved with training for other mission organizations with a similar vision.

They strive to maintain their relationships with refugees from multiple countries—Syria, Afghanistan, Iraq, Iran, and more—sharing the Lord's love in many ways. They have also seen an increase in involvement in training for Arabic and Farsi speakers via the European Training Center (ETC) and the All Nations Hub in Hamburg. This has been a great development that was expected and fits their gifting and calling. Sandra has also been involved in trauma counseling training.

This past year, their focus has been evangelism and discipleship in the context of relationships. They are cultivating trusting, long-term relationships with refugees and potential leaders. This includes the continuation of the Persian/Iranian group and International Gathering, as well as broader work with Persians throughout Germany. They participated and ministered at a wonderful conference for Iranians, as well as leadership training at the All Nations Hub Persian community. They also took a trip to France to connect with a UNIPREF pastor (a French Presbyterian denomination).

Adger and Sandra also do evangelism at a local refugee café, in the homes of refugees, in an international group, and in a Persian-speaking group, as well as traveling to Egypt.
