SPOTLIGHT // ECUADOR RECAP

The Student Ministry of Signal Pres and The House, a college ministry at UTC, traveled to Ecuador to partner with one of our global ministry partners, For His Children, over New Years. For His Children provides personalized care to vulnerable and orphaned children in Ecuador who have experienced abandonment, abuse, or neglect. They have two homes located in Latacunga and Quito, and our team of 10 got to spend time at both campuses.

For His Children provides for children and young adults with normal and special needs. While the hope of this ministry is for the children to either be reunited to their family or adopted by 16 (the maximum age of adoption within Ecuador) they do provide long term care for young adults with special needs and commit to being the permanent home and forever family for these individuals.

Every evening, we studied a passage of scripture where fire appears. This theme was chosen because of the Ecuadorian New Year's tradition that revolves around fire. It was so neat learning about where there is fire in the pages of scripture there the presence of God is near.

The students were just spectacular. They were "all in" from day one and loved, played, and led long and hard sharing the very real love and hope of God with the children and Tias. It was an immense gift to spend 10 days with this amazing ministry and to learn more of God's heart for and toward those that the world often deems as unimportant and remember Jesus' promise to his disciples before he goes to the cross, "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you."
