GLOBAL MISSIONARY SPOTLIGHT

Timothy Two Project International

This month, in April, Lara was able to join me as I taught a workshop on "Knowing God," which looks at the attributes of God over 21 sessions in four days, in Andes, Antioquia, Colombia. Though only 71 miles from Medellín, Colombia, it took over three hours to drive there because of the curvy, mountainous roads, with no stretches straight enough to pass slow trucks. The group that invited me was with the "Iglesia Cuadrangular," or the "Foursquare Gospel Church."

One of God's attributes that impacted some of the participants was the sovereignty of God, specifically as it applies to God's promise in Philippians 1:6 (NIV): "Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."

It brought great comfort to those who have children who have strayed from the Lord. They could see that it is God's sovereignty that worked in their lives to bring them to faith, and it is His power that will continue that work in their lives until Christ returns.

I imagine that, much like in the times of the early church, when the pagan temples were massively impressive buildings in places like Ephesus, Athens, and Rome, Christians may have felt like a small, insignificant group. Yet God used them to transform the Roman Empire.

Our prayer is that God will do the same in places like Colombia.

Paul's missionary strategy, which conquered the Roman Empire, was this strategy that he passed on to his protégé, Timothy: "And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also." 2 Timothy 2:2 (ESV)

This is the calling we have with Timothy Two Project International. We go into under-resourced areas and seek to train pastors and leaders, many of whom have not had the opportunity to attend seminary or Bible school, so that they can reach their own people. All of this is only possible through the gifts of God's people.
