GLOBAL MISSIONS SPOTLIGHT

World Outreach EPC
Adger and Sandra McKay
Germany

Adger and Sandra McKay work with World Outreach to serve Syrian refugees in Europe. They are involved in engaging displaced people among refugee communities in Germany and beyond.

Their ministry statement is to “love the person that God puts in front of you and share his truth.” They do this by maintaining relationships with refugees to show his heart and share his love and the gospel. They have also expanded their ministry to include their giftings through training and teaching, as well as trauma counseling.

They work with displaced people from Afghanistan, Iran, Iraq, Syria, and more who are part of God's great plan for the Diaspora, sharing the Lord's love and truth in many ways. They are also involved in training with other missions organizations that share a similar vision. Adger and Sandra strive to maintain relationships with refugees from multiple countries, including Syria, Afghanistan, Iraq, Iran, and more. They have also seen an increase in opportunities to train Arabic and Farsi speakers through the European Training Center (ETC) and the All Nations hub in Hamburg. This has been a wonderful development that fits their gifting and calling. Sandra has also been involved in trauma counseling training.

This past year, their focus has been evangelism and discipleship in the context of relationships. They continue to cultivate trusting, long-term relationships with refugees and potential leaders. Their ministry includes the continuation of a Persian/Iranian group and International Gathering, as well as broader work with Persians throughout Germany. They also participated and ministered at a wonderful conference for Iranians and were involved in leadership training with the Persian community at the All Nations hub. In addition, they traveled to France to connect with a UNIPREF pastor (a French Presbyterian denomination).

Adger and Sandra also do evangelism at a local refugee café and in the homes of refugees, an international group, and a Persian-speaking group. Their ministry has also taken them to Egypt.
