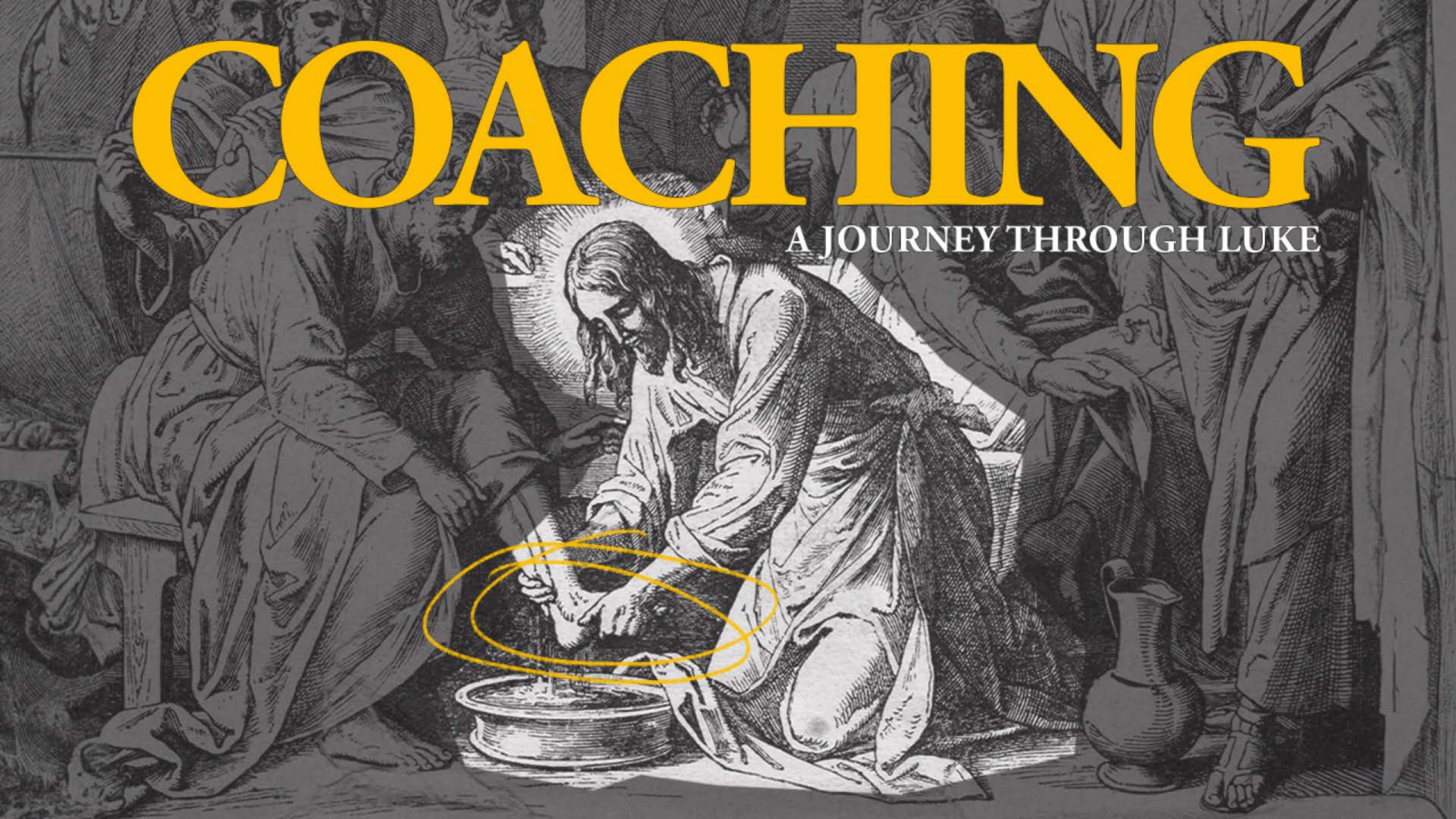

“Your kingdom come.”




Our desperate need for God

Jesus fills us


And when it comes, it finds the house swept and put in order. Then it goes and brings seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there.
