Contrasts: Clothing - purple vs. sores Home - gate vs. none Food - lavish vs. none



The rich one thought wealth was evidence of being "in" with God.



Luke3:8 (ESV) Bear fruits in keeping with repentance. And do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I tell you, God is able from these stones to raise up children for Abraham.

Luke 16:30 (ESV)
And he said, 'No, father Abraham,
but if someone goes to them from the
dead, they will repent.'



Luke 16:31 (ESV)
He said to him, 'If they do not hear
Moses and the Prophets, neither will
they be convinced if someone should
rise from the dead.'
