2 Timothy 4:1-2

I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching.

- 1. Preach: Who did you speak Jesus to this week? What's your 90-second story?
- 2. Word: Read a chunk of Scripture together. What do you see? What did you notice?
- 3. Ready: How did you spend time in the word of God this week? What did that look like? What has God been teaching you?
 - 4. Reprove: What is something God has been convicting you to stop, change, or start?

- 5. Rebuke: Is there anything in your life you would like me to hold you accountable for?
- 6. Exhort: What one concrete act of obedience will you do before we meet again?
 - 7. Patience: Remember, this isn't about you, or about what is frustrating you. They must take ownership of their faith. So, teach them patiently.
- 8. Teach-Back: From today's passage, what truth will you teach someone else, and to whom? When?

2 Timothy 4:5

As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

Fulfill your ministry-Speak Jesus.
