Isaiah 11:1 (ESV)

There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch (netser)from his roots shall bear fruit.

Christs Visits

GRACE

Luke 1:28 ...O favored One

Luke 1:30 ... found favor with God

Jesus = Yah[weh] saves

2 Samuel 7:16 (ESV) And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne will be established forever.

Christs Visits

Isaiah 9:6-7 (ESV)

...His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace..."

Christs Visits Daniel 7:14 (ESV)

And to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him; His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom one that thrists visits shall not be destroyed.

1:18 "How shall I know this?"

1:34 "How will this be?"

Luke 1:37 (ESV)
For nothing [no word/promise] will be impossible with God.

Moses/Miriam - Exodus 15 Deborah - Judges 5 Hannah - 1 Samuel 2 Asaph - 1 Chronicles 16

God will deliver! (judgment against evil)

God will be gracious! (saving the surrendered)

The unlikely one is the focus of God's favor.

God starts with grace and moves toward the birth.

Christ¹Stmas Christs Visits Everything God has done is proof God will keep every promise.

Surrendering to Jesus will impact our earthly relationships.

Surrendering to Jesus gives a new identity = highly favored!

God visits: See others as objects of God's favor.
