# The Promise of Restoration 1 Peter 5:10-11 And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace...will Himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you...

### Confirm – verify our new identity – we are saved!

### Strengthen – inject with inner power

### Establish – build a foundation – we will not lose
