- 2 Which imagine mischiefs in their heart; Continually are they gathered together for war.
- 3 They have sharpened their tongues like a serpent; Adders' poison is under their lips. Selah.
- 4 Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; Preserve me from the violent man; Who have purposed to overthrow my goings.
- 5 The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; They have spread a net by the wayside; They have set gins for me. Selah.
- 6 I said unto the LORD, Thou art my God: Hear the voice of my supplications, O LORD.

Corporate Prayer from Psalm 140

This prayer will draw from Psalm 140 as an example for how we can direct prayers against enemies in a godly way.

Pray One at a Time for Any Prayers That Are Requested Now. Let's Focus Our Prayers on Preservation from Enemies: Sin, Satan, Death, Violent and Oppressive People, Wars, etc.

Share prayer requests one at a time. Use portions of the passage above to direct your prayers. Either Pastor John will pray for that request or request if someone else would like to pray aloud for it.

Example Prayer Requests to Pray Now and/or Later

- Individuals pray aloud one at a time for a church member or attendee (examples below). Focus on concise requests without informing God of what He knows and without giving general praise. Pray for one person and matter at a time. Be discreet and prudent with what you say in public prayer. God knows the details.

- Example things to pray for individuals: will and power to obey and escape sin through God's provision; faith and peace in trials; healing and obedience in health afflictions; increased love for God and others; sustained hope and joy in our future resurrection.

(Let us know if you want added or removed before future prayer meetings.)

- Leaders and influencers of our workplaces, county, state, nation, and nations. Pray for God to free the people of Iran, Venezuela, China, Russia, North Korea, Nigeria, and many other nations. Pray for God to send forth His church with the gospel into these nations. Pray for God to use the present technological revolutions to spread the gospel and present more need for us to live according to the purpose for which we were created. May God fill the earth with His church and gospel!
