The PERSISTANCE of the Overcomer's Prayer
Jesus and Paul both told believers to persist in prayer
Q: What does it mean to "pray always?"
The <b>POSSIBILITIES</b> of the Overcomer's Prayer  • PRAY in all  • When we're thankful, confession, sick, tempted, in danger
<ul> <li>PRAY in all</li> <li>NT – in the temple, on a mountain, on a housetop, by the river, on a ship</li> <li>PRAY at all</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Never a time when we cannot pray</li> <li>PRAY for all</li> <li>NT – safety, forgiveness, other people, faith, healing, wisdom, relief from</li> </ul>
suffering, children, health, prosperity, strength

The **PETITION** of the Overcomer's Prayer (Asking) James 4:2 "You don't have because you don't ask." If God already knows our needs, why pray?

## 4 Reasons

- Maintain and deepen our connection with God
- God wants us to want what He knows we should have
  - E. Stanley Jones puts it this way: "Prayer is surrender—surrender to the will of God and cooperation with that will. If I throw out a boat-hook from the boat and catch hold of the shore and pull, do I pull the shore to me, or do I pull myself to the shore? Prayer is not pulling God to my will, but the aligning of my will to the will of God."
- So we will acknowledge that He is the source of all we have
- Preparation So that our capacity to receive His gifts would be enlarged

- "They continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers" (Acts 2:42).
- "We will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word" (Acts 6:4).
- "Rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer" (Rom. 12:12).

To pray effectively is to persevere, no matter how soaring or how earthbound your prayers feel. No matter how focused, failing, or frantic you feel. The more you pray in all circumstances, the more you align your will with God's, which will mean more visible answers. DJ

- Jesus set the example when He prayed for His disciples: "I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours" (John 17:9).
- Paul regularly prayed for those in the churches he visited, making mention of them always in his prayers (Rom. 1:9; Eph. 1:16).
- Job's three friends angered God with their presumptuous judgments, but we read "the Lord restored Job's losses when he prayed for his friends" (Job 42:10). DJ
