Read John 15:18-16:4

1. Read 15:18-19. What makes people of the world appreciate Christians?
2. What makes people of the world hate Christians?
3. Is it loving or unloving to tell a non-Christian that they can only go to heaven if they believe in Jesus as Lord and Savior? Explain why.
4. Read 16:1, 4. Why does Jesus warn the disciples of the hatred that is to come? How does that warning help us today?
5. What are the implications if the world sees little difference between you (Christians) and them (non-Christians)?
6. Read 16:2. Why did some think they were serving God by killing Christians?
7. What do people do today against Christians, thinking that they're doing a service to God?
8. Read 15:26-27. Why do we need the Holy Spirit's help to bear witness about who Jesus is?
9. What are the dangers of witnessing about Jesus? What is our goal when we witness?
10. Does it make sense to share that Jesus died for your sins without mentioning heaven or hell?
11. If someone legitimately thought you were going to hell because of your beliefs, wouldn't you want to know? Then why is it so hard for us to tell this to others?
