


"These interludes encourage God's people in the midst of the fury and horror of divine judgment, and remind them that God is still in sovereign control of all events.

"The revelation of an ark in the heavenly Temple no more precludes the continued existence of the earthly ark than the existence of the heavenly altar of sacrifice means the earthly one has been relocated to Heaven."

"The ark symbolizes God's communion with the redeemed because it was there that blood sacrifices were offered to atone for men's sins (Lev. 16:2–16; Heb. 9:3–7). Also, it was from
above the ark that God spoke to Moses (Num. 7:89). The ark of the covenant is called in Scriptur, the ark of testimony (Ex. 25:22), the ark of God (1 Sam. 3:3), and the ark of God's strength
(Psa. 132:8). Inside it was 'a golden jar holding the manna, and Aaron's rod which budded, and the tables of the covenant' (Heb. 9:4). All that symbolized that God would supply His people
was sovereign over His people, gave His law to His people, and entered into an eternal saving
covenant with His people."







iA. The ERSONAGE OF THE FALSE PROPHET (V. 11)

"False prophets often appear meek, mild, and harmless. They offer hope and solutions to the problems troubling men and women. Yet they are ever the voices of hell, and when they open their mouths, Satan speaks. So it will be amid the unspeakable horrors of the Tribulation. The False Prophet will come like a lamb, speaking false, deceptive words of comfort. He will promise the suffering, tormented people of the world that all will be well if only they will worship Antichrist. But those who fall for his subtle lies will face the terrifying judgment of God."

"This type of persuasiveness contrasts with the first beast's loud blasphemy against all heavenly things (13:6). This is not blustering fierceness, but deceptive, subtle, seductive speech to lure people away from faith in Christ and into the dragon's trap."



Quote:

"These will be genuine miracles, supernatural accomplishments, not mere trickery or skill in pyrotechnics. They will almost deceive the elect (Matt. 24:24), but the faithful will recognize them for what they are because of the purpose for which they are performed and the doctrine that they seek to prove."

Quote:		

Each and every experience (must be) tested against its adherence to that which God has already revealed in Scripture. When and if an experience fails the test of Scripture, it (must be) rejected, for we know that the Spirit of God speaks consistently. That which is of the Holy Spirit is in agreement with that which is authored through the Holy Spirit: "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world" (1 Jn. 4:1). Thus, the Biblical believer evaluates the fruit of his experience against the measure of Scripture and avoids deception (Acts 8:9-11; Deut. 13:1-4).

"The purpose of the mark will be to serve as a sign of identification of those who will own the Antichrist as their god. Only those who have this number will be permitted to work, to buy, to sell, or simply to make a living."


"Currency will probably vanish, to be replaced by controlled credit. Instead of a credit card, which can be lost, people will have a mark in their forehead or hand. Scanning people's foreheads or hands would identify them to a central computer system."


Quote:

"For those who are in the Church Age, the number of the Beast, as fascinating a puzzle as it may be, is of relatively little importance. For the Church will not be present when he is revealed. This is by design, for we are to maintain a watch for Christ, not Antichrist! We are commanded to look for our Bridegroom, not a coming global despot (Phil. 3:20)."



"Like a multifaceted jewel, Scripture describes the gospel in various terms, each looking at it from a different viewpoint. The gospel is called the gospel of the kingdom (Matt. 4:23), the gospel of Jesus Christ (Mark 1:1), the gospel of God (Mark 1:14), the gospel of the grace of God (Acts 20:24), the gospel of the glory of Christ (2 Cor. 4:4), the gospel of salvation (Eph. 1:13), the gospel of peace (Eph. 6:15), and the glorious gospel (1 Tim. 1:11). Here it is described as eternal because it provides the means to eternal life. It is the good news that God will forgive all the sins of those who repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the only way of salvation, and by that repentance and saving faith take them into His eternal kingdom."






