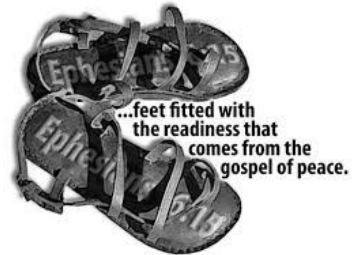
**Isaiah 52:8 NIV**

**Isaiah 52:9 NIV**

*Burst into songs of joy together, you ruins of Jerusalem, for the LORD has comforted his people, he has redeemed Jerusalem.*
