

1. In a couple of sentences, try to summarize the “story” of scripture. What does it mean to say, “all of scripture points to Jesus?”
2. Read Luke 24:13-26: What do we learn here about these individuals on the road to Emmaus? What disappointments have they experienced? What flaws do you find in their beliefs and expectations that many Christians today may still experience?
3. Read Luke 24:27: Jesus taught these disciples using the Law and Prophets (a comprehensive term referring to the Old Testament), that all of scripture pointed to Him. What are some Old Testament texts Jesus may have brought up in this sermon?
4. Read Luke 24:28-31: In this section, we see these individuals who previously were spiritually blinded, now see Christ. As a group look up 2 Corinthians 4:4, John 9:24-25, and Romans 10:17. How do these verses relate to the concept of spiritual blindness, and how Christians should relate to those who are spiritually blind?
5. Read Luke 24:32-35: What does it mean when they say, “weren’t our hearts burning within us?” What is the reaction of the disciples after they experience Jesus? What does it say about us if we have no desire to tell others about Jesus? What is one key change you can make in your life to develop a greater intimacy with Jesus?
