

1. Read Luke 24:36-43: What evidence does Jesus give to demonstrate that He truly rose from the dead? What evidence of the resurrection may be worthwhile bringing up when discussing the gospel with a non-Christian?
2. What is significant about Jesus saying, “Peace to you,” in verse 36, considering how these disciples had behaved a few days earlier? What comfort does this bring to you?
3. Read Luke 24:44-48: What elements of the gospel does Jesus say were foretold in the Law, Prophets, and Psalms? What are some passages that reference these elements? Why is it important to always bring people back to scripture when sharing the gospel?
4. Read Luke 24:49: What is the promise that Jesus is referring to here? Why is this promise so important to remember in our evangelism (sharing the gospel)?
5. Read Luke 24:50-52: What is significant about Jesus’ ascension when thinking about how we share the gospel (cf. Matthew 28:18)?
6. Which tool for sharing the gospel stuck out to you the most in the sermon? How will you incorporate this into your evangelism? Spend time praying for people and opportunities to evangelize.
