The challenges of funding the replacement cost of the East Salem Seventh- \$200,000 day Adventist Church sewage system provides an opportunity to enhance our trust in God and to exercise the ministry of stewardship which the Bible so clearly demonstrates God's people cannot out give the Giver of all providence.
