Faithfulness.

Maintaining faith or allegiance; showing a strong sense of duty or conscientiousness. In biblical Hebrew, "faith" and "faithfulness" are grammatically related.

Human Faithfulness.

Faith and faithfulness are logically and linguistically one in the OT and NT

God's Faithfulness.

In spite of Israel's faithlessness (Dt 32:20; cf. Rom 3:3), God showed himself to be absolutely reliable. His faithfulness is great.

The pinnacle of faithfulness in the Bible is seen in the work of Jesus Christ, who showed himself faithful to his Father (Heb 3:2) and in his witness (Rev. 1:5).


