The Faithful Steward of Relationships Part 10

Today we will look into God's view concerning the primary purposes of relationships.

Pastor Stuart's Principles/Methods:

- Prayerful Practice: Praying for people by name. Live in a constant communication with God, so that you are consistently personalizing your prayer for everyone you engage. (Col. 4:2-6; Acts 26:18; 2 Tim. 2:24-26)
- 2. **Lifestyle Evangelism:** Think, live, and behave with the supreme focus of the salvation of souls. (Proverbs 11:30; 2 Tim. 4:2)
- Loving God and Others: Live with and love others in such a way that evangelism becomes a behavior adapted by those around you. (1 Cor. 11:1)
- Enteral Focus: Viewing every relationship with an enteral perspective—evangelism or discipleship. (1 Corinthians 9:19-23)
- 5. Fear or Faith: Maintaining a constant perspective on the importance of properly placed faith—or fear. (Matthew 19:25-26; Matthew 10: 28)
- 6. **Confidence in Conviction:** With every conversation your involved, remember God remains steadfast and constant— convicting the lost of their need for Christ. (John 16:8-11)

7. **Death and Eternity:** In this life, every person suffers or suppresses a fear of death and the fact of eternity. (Hebrews 2: 14-15; Eccl. 3:11)

In closing ...

The faithful steward of relationship remains primarily concerned with their relationship with Jesus- revealing the intimacy, depth, and love of that relationship with all others.
