Q: What thing remains a gain to Paul, no matter the cost?

- Divine ability, strength and gifting's, or the gift of participating in suffering, even and including death.
- Examining The Gain (vs. 8B-11):
 Any way to grow closer to Jesus; through experience, divine power, partnership in suffering, or death, all is worth gaining more of Him.

- A renewed mind removes the world-view of gain and provides a heavenly view.


