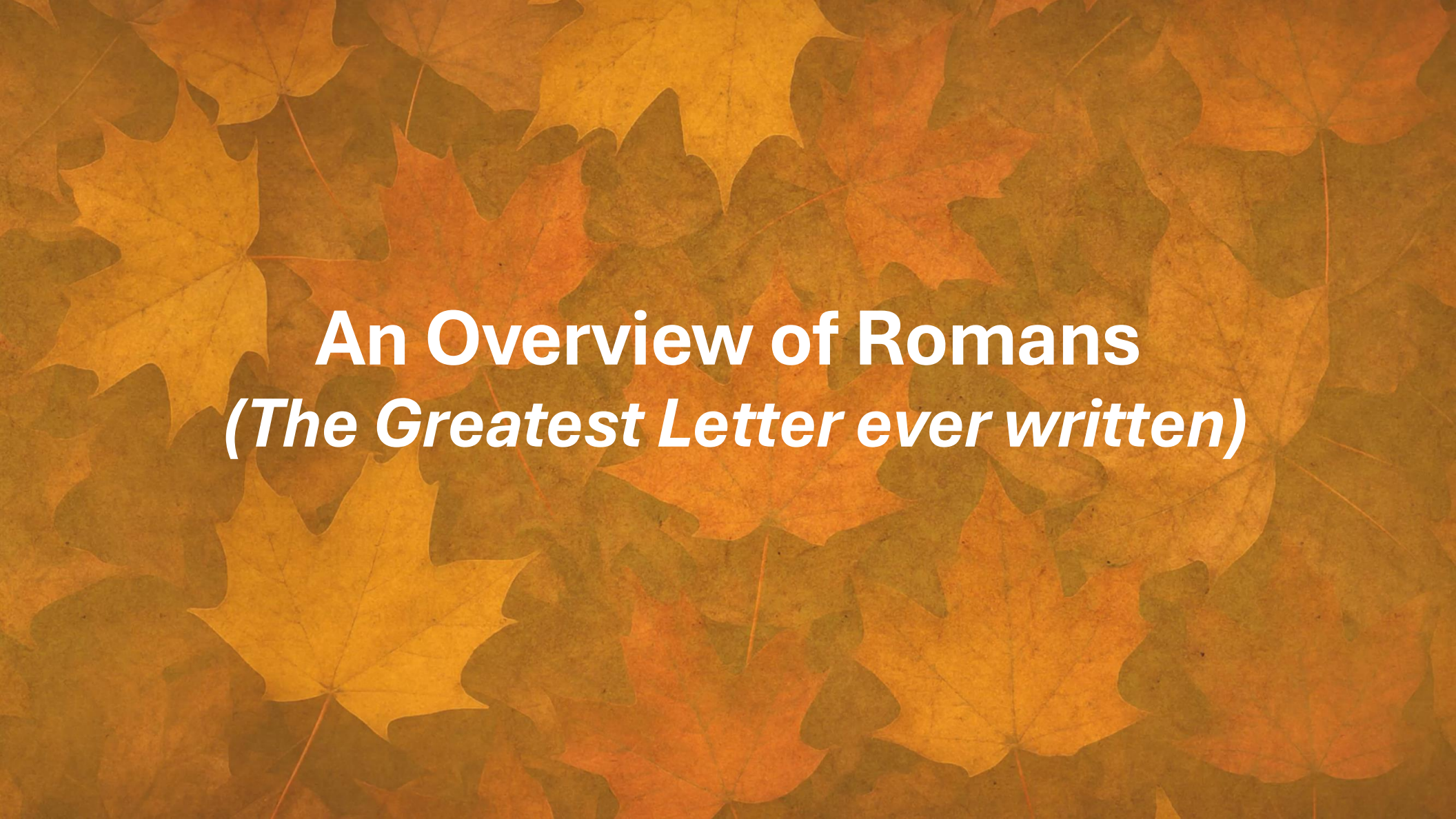

# The Problem: Our Need for the Gospel's Power [Chapters 1-3]

Romans 1:16

Romans 1:18

# **The Problem: Our Need for the Gospel's Power**

## **[Chapters 1-3]**

Romans 2:9-11 “There will be tribulation and distress for EVERY human being who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek...For God shows NO partiality.”

# The Solution: The Gospel's Power for Us [Chapters 4-11]

Romans 4:24-25 and 5:1

“It will be counted to us who BELIEVE in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our JUSTIFICATION.

Therefore, since we have been JUSTIFIED by FAITH, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

# **The Solution: The Gospel's Power for Us [Chapters 4-11]**

Romans 6:4 and 11

“We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in NEWNESS of LIFE.”

“So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.”

# The Solution: The Gospel's Power for Us [Chapters 4-11]

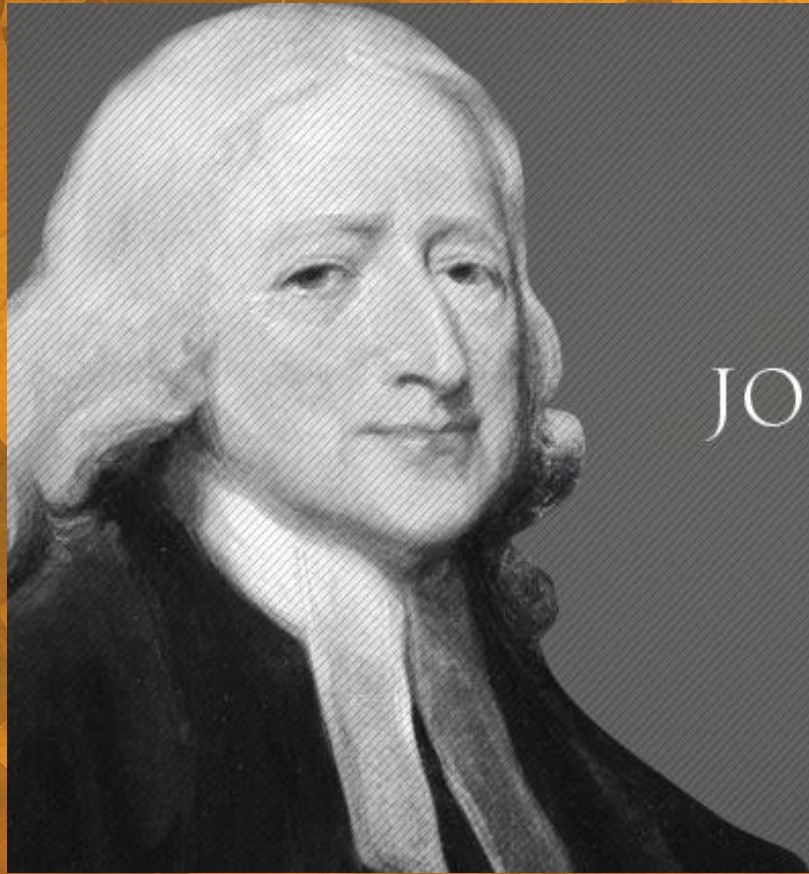
Romans 8:6
