Matthew 7:7-8 (KJV)

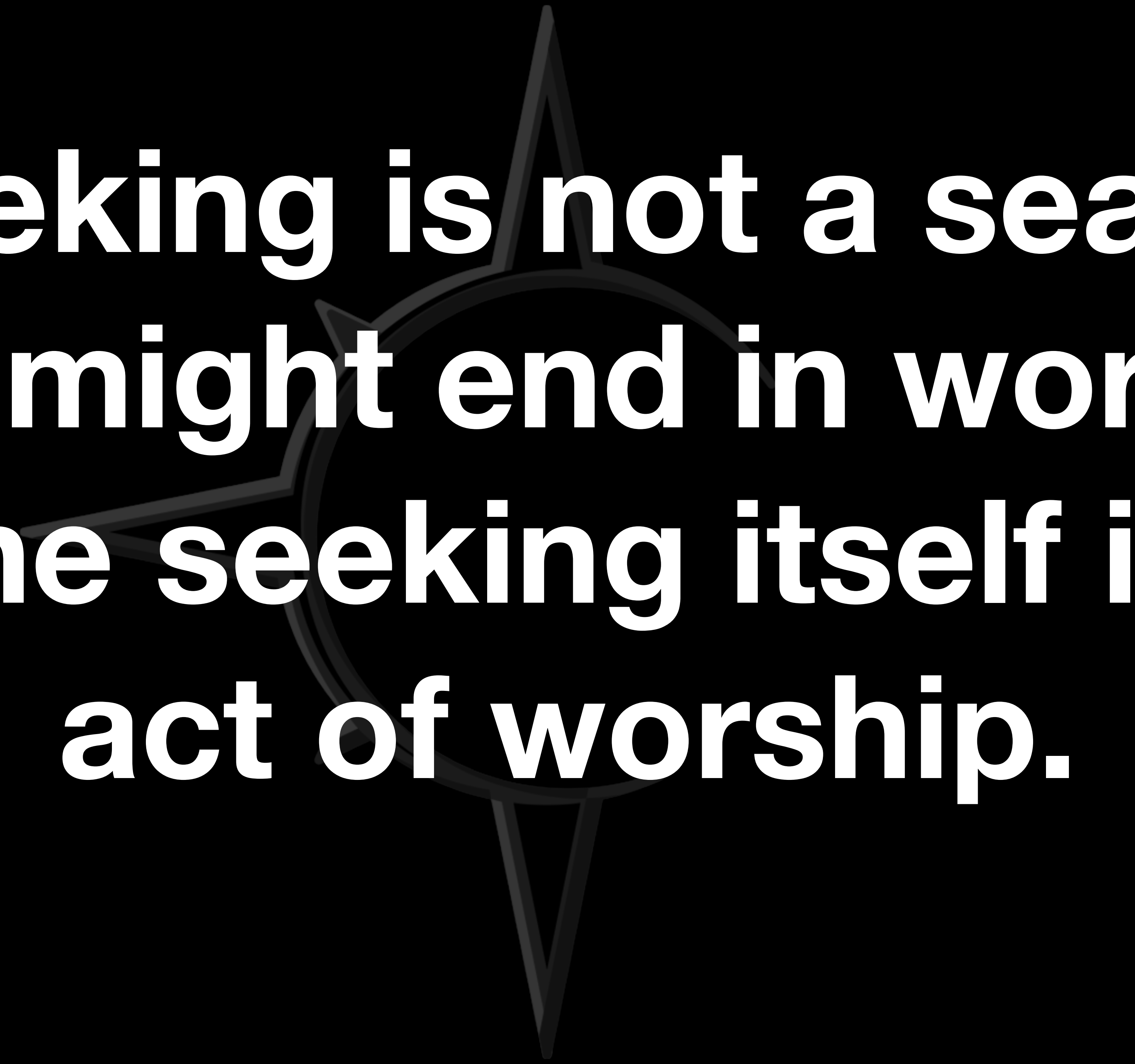
Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

Seek = ζητέω = zēteō = to seek specifically, to worship (God), or (in a bad sense) to plot (against life): —be (go) about, desire, endeavour, enquire (for), require, (X will) seek (after, for, means).



**Seeking is not a search
that might end in worship
— the seeking itself is an
act of worship.**

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them



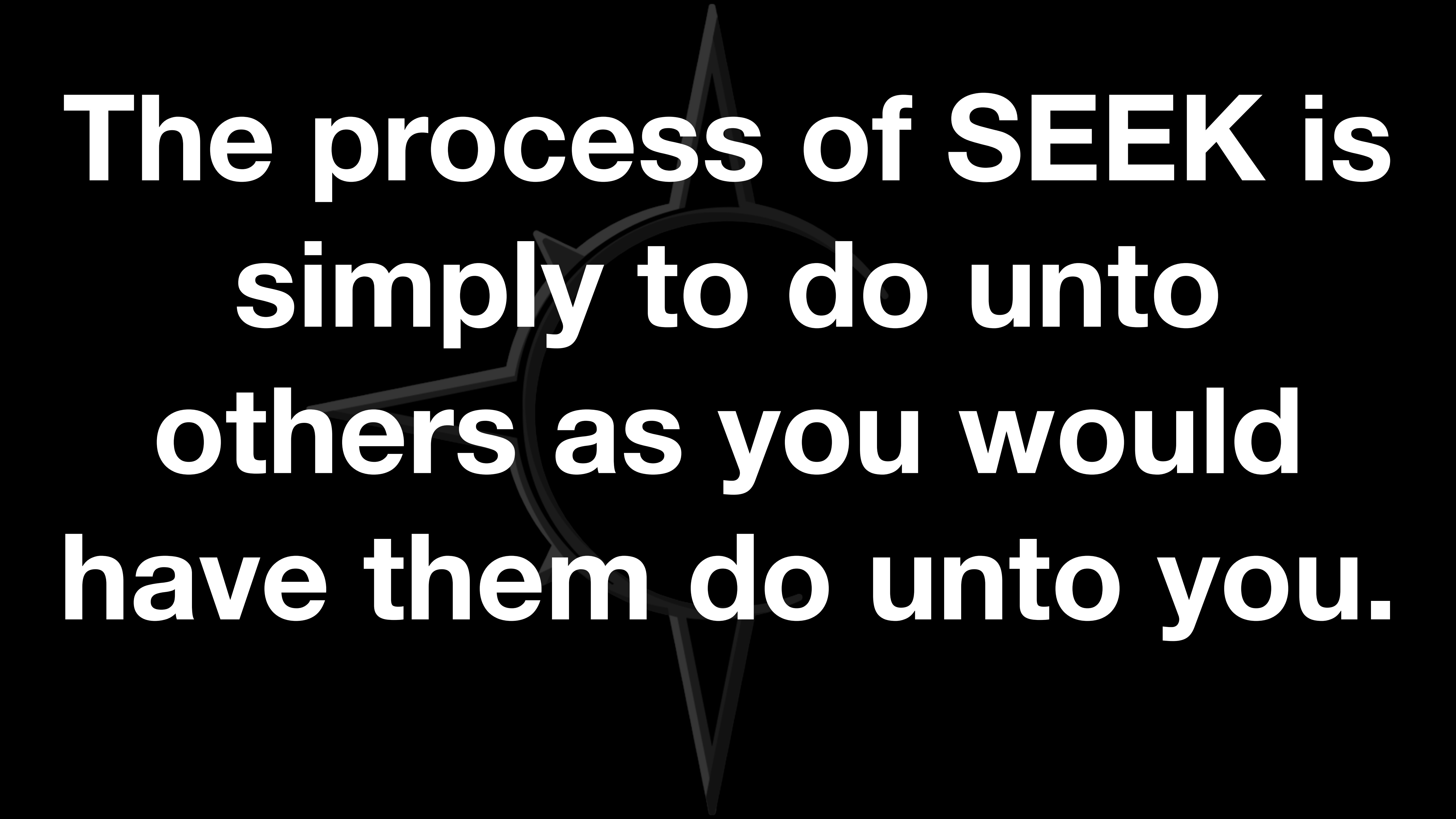
**HOW TO SEEK:

Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?

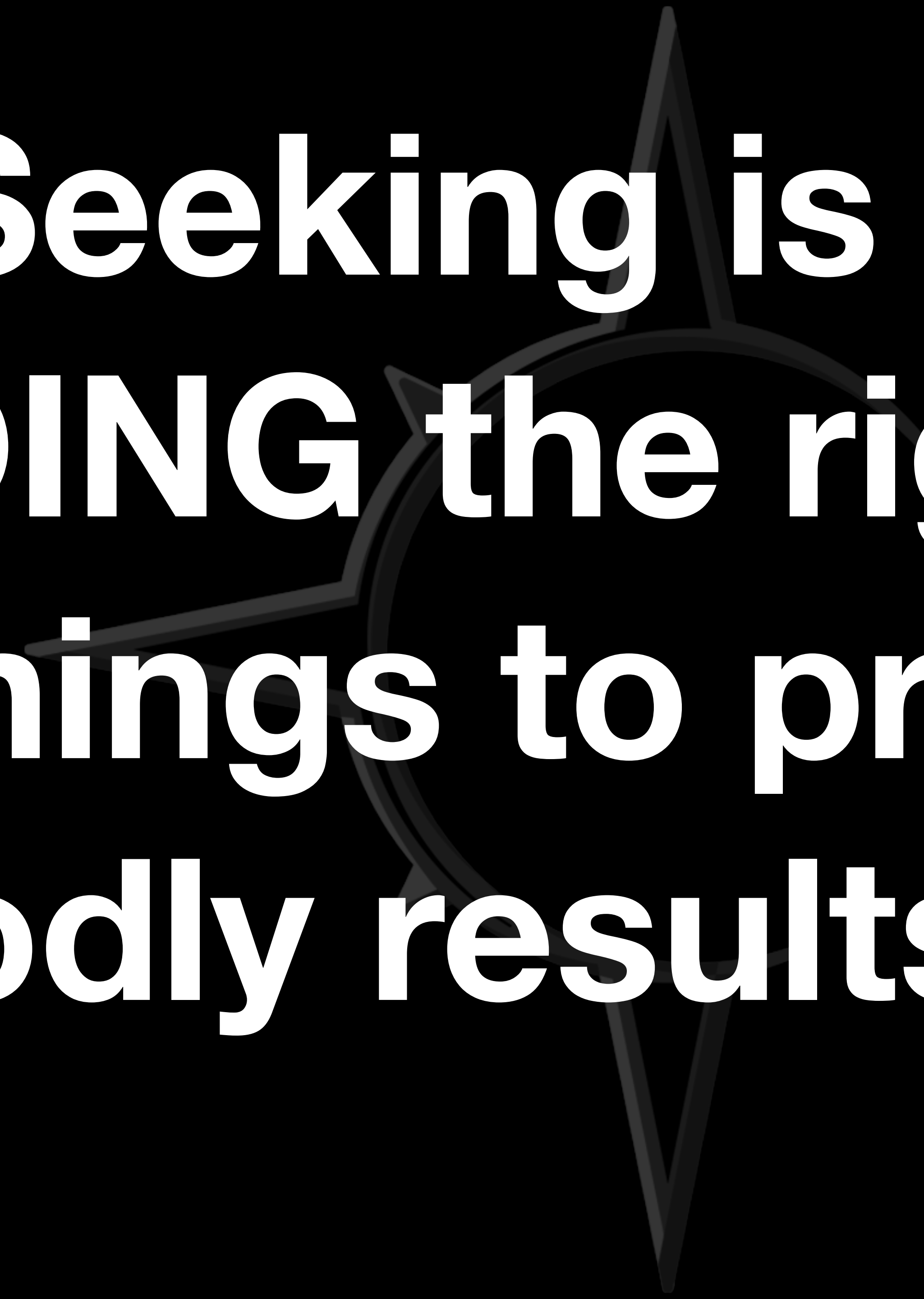
Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.

Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

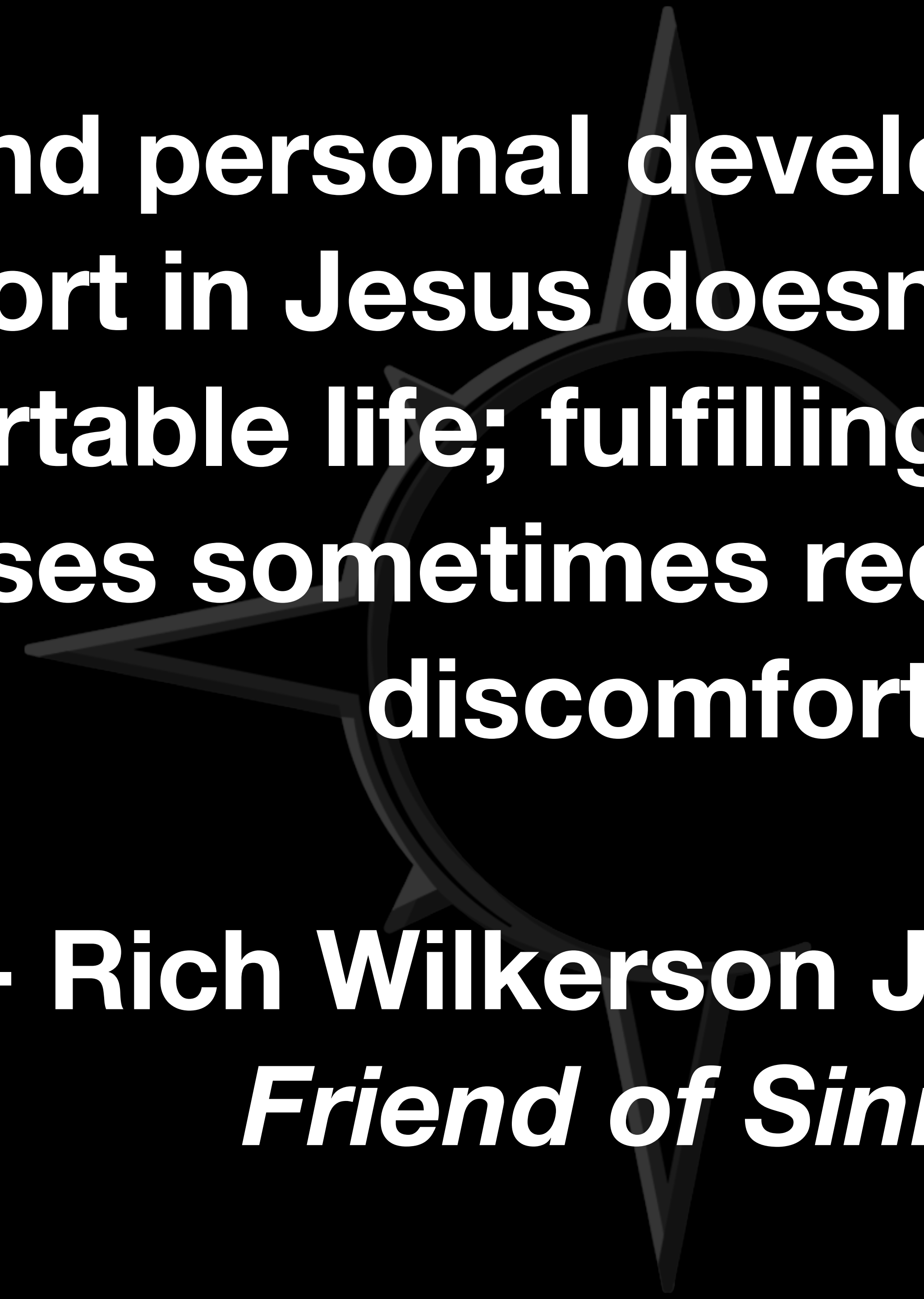
