Jonah 1:4 & 6-7 (KJV)

But the LORD sent out a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken.

So the shipmaster came to him, and said unto him, What meanest thou, O sleeper? arise, call upon thy God, if so be that God will think upon us, that we perish not.

And they said every one to his fellow, Come, and let us cast lots, that we may know for whose cause this evil *is* upon us. So they cast lots, and the lot fell upon Jonah.

Jonah 1:16-17 (KJV)

Then the men feared the LORD exceedingly, and offered a sacrifice unto the LORD, and made vows.

Spiritual Storms (Battles)

Mark 4:35-38 (KJV)

And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, **Let us pass over unto the other side.**

And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships.

And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.

And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?

Mark 4:39-41 (KJV)

And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, **Peace, be still.** And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

And he said unto them, **Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?**

And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

Mark 5:6-9 (KJV 1900)

But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him,

And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.

For he said unto him, **Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.**

And he asked him, **What is thy name?** And he answered, saying, My name is Legion: for we are many.

Psalm 29:1-4 (KJV)

Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength.

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

The voice of the LORD *is* upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth: the LORD *is* upon many waters.

The voice of the LORD *is* powerful; the voice of the LORD *is* full of majesty.

Psalm 29:5-8 (KJV)

**The voice of the LORD breaketh the cedars;
yea, the LORD breaketh the cedars of Lebanon.**

**He maketh them also to skip like a calf;
Lebanon and Sirion like a young unicorn.**

**The voice of the LORD divideth the flames of
fire.**

**The voice of the LORD shaketh the wilderness;
the LORD shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh.**

Psalm 29:9-11 (KJV)

The voice of the LORD maketh the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forests: and in his temple doth every one speak of *his* glory.

The LORD sitteth upon the flood; yea, the LORD sitteth King for ever.

The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.

**VOICE = KOLE = to
call a loud
proclamation, to sing,
to thunder**

Exodus 20:18 (KJV)

And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw *it*, they removed, and stood afar off.

**Wilderness = midbar = a dry
place, a desert.**

**Kadesh = Wilderness of
Wandering, desert of a fugitive**
