What is Love?

Ephesians 3:20-21 (KJV)

Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

Unto him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

Ephesians 3:16-19 (KJV 1900)

That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,

May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

And to know the **love** of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

1 John 4:7–9 (KJV 1900)

Beloved, let us **love** one another: for **love** is of God; and every one that **loveth** is born of God, and knoweth God.

He that **loveth** not knoweth not God; for God is **love**.

In this was manifested the **love** of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

1 John 4:10-13 (KJV 1900)

Herein is **love**, not that we **loved** God, but that he **loved** us, and sent his Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

Beloved, if God so **loved** us, we ought also to **love** one another.

No man hath seen God at any time. If we **love** one another, God dwelleth in us, and his **love** is perfected in us.

Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit.

LOVE = ἀγαπάω^a; ἀγάπη^a, ης *f*: to have love for someone or something, based on sincere appreciation and high regard — ‘to love, to regard with affection, loving concern, love.

LOVE = ἀγάπη^b = a special type of communal meal having particular significance for early Christians as an expression of their mutual affection and concern—‘**fellowship meal.**’

The meaning of ἀγάπη^b may be rendered in some languages as ‘meals in which you show your love for one another as you eat together’ or ‘your eating together as the result of your love for one another

In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat.

But he said unto them, **I have meat to eat that ye know not of.**
