
LET LOVE ARISE

Revelation 2:1-4 (AMP)

"Write this letter to the angel of the church in Ephesus... patient endurance. I know you don't tolerate evil people. You have discovered they are liars. not grown weary [of being faithful to the truth]).

[you have lost the depth of love that you first had for Me].

Revelation 2:5-7 (AMP)

So remember the heights from which you have fallen, and repent [change your inner self--your old way of thinking, your sinful behavior-seek God's will] and do the works you did at first [when you first knew Me]; otherwise, I will visit you and remove your lampstand (the church, the congregation and its impact) from its place--unless you repent. Yet you have this [to your credit], that you hate the works and corrupt teachings of the Nicolaitans [that mislead and delude the people], which I also hate. "Anyone with ears to hear must listen to the Spirit and understand

what he is saying to the churches. To everyone who is victorious I will give fruit from the tree of life in the paradise of God.

Paul wrote in (Ephesians 1:15) "I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints", in (Ephesians 2:15), and how they had come together to form "one new man," in (Ephesians 2:16) "one body". They were multiethnic as well as diverse in their socioeconomic make-up. Paul commends the church in (Ephesians 6:24) on their sincerity and faithfulness in the final sentence of his letter stating: Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ with undying and incorruptible love.



Strongs #25 agapáo love = to prefer to love, its an action or choice to love; for the believer it means: those preferring to live their life through Christ, embracing God's will (choosing His choices) actively choosing to do what the Lord prefers, living life led by His direction and sustained by His power.

Revelation 2:4

I have this [charge] against you, that you have left (abandon, forsaken) your first love [your early love, you have lost the depth of love that you first had for

STRONGS NT #26 agapen, from #25 agapao: affection, goodwill, longing for, take pleasure in, unconditional, sacrificial, love-feast



"Your love, the first one, you have left." the phrase "you have left" is from a Greek word (aphiemi), which denotes the voluntary release, disregard, neglect, the forsaking or separation of something that was once held dear, something that held value.

2 Timothy 1:6 (ANP) For this reason I remind you to fan into flames (rekindle) (keep ablaze) the gift of God, which is in YOU





Galatians 6:9 (AMP) We can't allow ourselves to get tired of living the right way. Certainly, each of us will receive [everlasting life] at the proper time, if we don't give up.



Let us repent, making the decision to return to our first love, rearranging our thinking to allow for a transformation, committing to his Ways



Let us renew ourselves, becoming new creatures, replacing the old, becoming better, transforming our minds, dusting off the gifting, putting into action what God placed has within us



Let us revive ourselves, let spiritual awakening from a state of slumber and coldness and stagnation come forth, let us be restored from a depressed, inactive, unused state, bringing back to life that which lies lifeless because of the distractions of life.
