**So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him.**



## Luke 19:9-10 (NLT)

## John 12:30–32 (NLT)

Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.



## James 4:6–8 (KJV 1900)

**Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.**

**Submit yourselves therefore to God.**

**Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.**

**Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you.**

## John 4:10 & 13-14 (KJV 1900)

Jesus answered and said unto her, **If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.**

**Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:**

**But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.**



## John 4:16-18 (KJV 1900)

Jesus saith unto her, **Go, call thy husband, and come hither.**

# Psalm 138:7 (KJV 1900)

Though I walk in the midst of  
trouble, thou wilt revive me: Thou  
shalt stretch forth thine hand  
against the wrath of mine enemies,  
And thy right hand shall save me.





**1. Revival causes  
the Conviction of  
Sin.**

## John 16:7–9 (NLT)

**But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Advocate (comforter/Holy Spirit) won't come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you.**

**And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment.**

**The world's sin is that it refuses to believe in me.**

## John 4:21–24 (KJV 1900)

Jesus saith unto her, **Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.**

**Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.**

**But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.**

**God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.**



## John 4:25–26 (KJV 1900)

The woman saith unto him, I know that **Messias** cometh, which is called **Christ**: when he is come, he will tell us all things.

Jesus saith unto her, **I that speak unto thee am he.**

## John 4:28–30 (KJV 1900)

The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men,

Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?

Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.

## John 4:31–33 (KJV 1900)

**In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat.**

**But he said unto them, I have meat to eat that ye know not of.**

**Therefore said the disciples one to another, Hath any man brought him ought to eat?**

## John 4:34–35 (KJV 1900)

Jesus saith unto them, **My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.**

**Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.**

**John 4:39–40 (KJV 1900)**

**And many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did.**

**So when the Samaritans were come unto him, they besought him that he would tarry with them: and he abode there two days.**



## John 4:41–42 (KJV 1900)

**And many more believed because of his own word;**

**And said unto the woman, Now we believe, not because of thy saying: for we have heard him ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world.**

## Jeremiah 29:11–14 (NLT)

**For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.**

**In those days when you pray, I will listen.**

**If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me.**

**I will be found by you,” says the Lord. “I will end your captivity and restore your fortunes. I will gather you out of the nations where I sent you and will bring you home again to your own land.”**



## Jeremiah 29:11 (MHKV)
