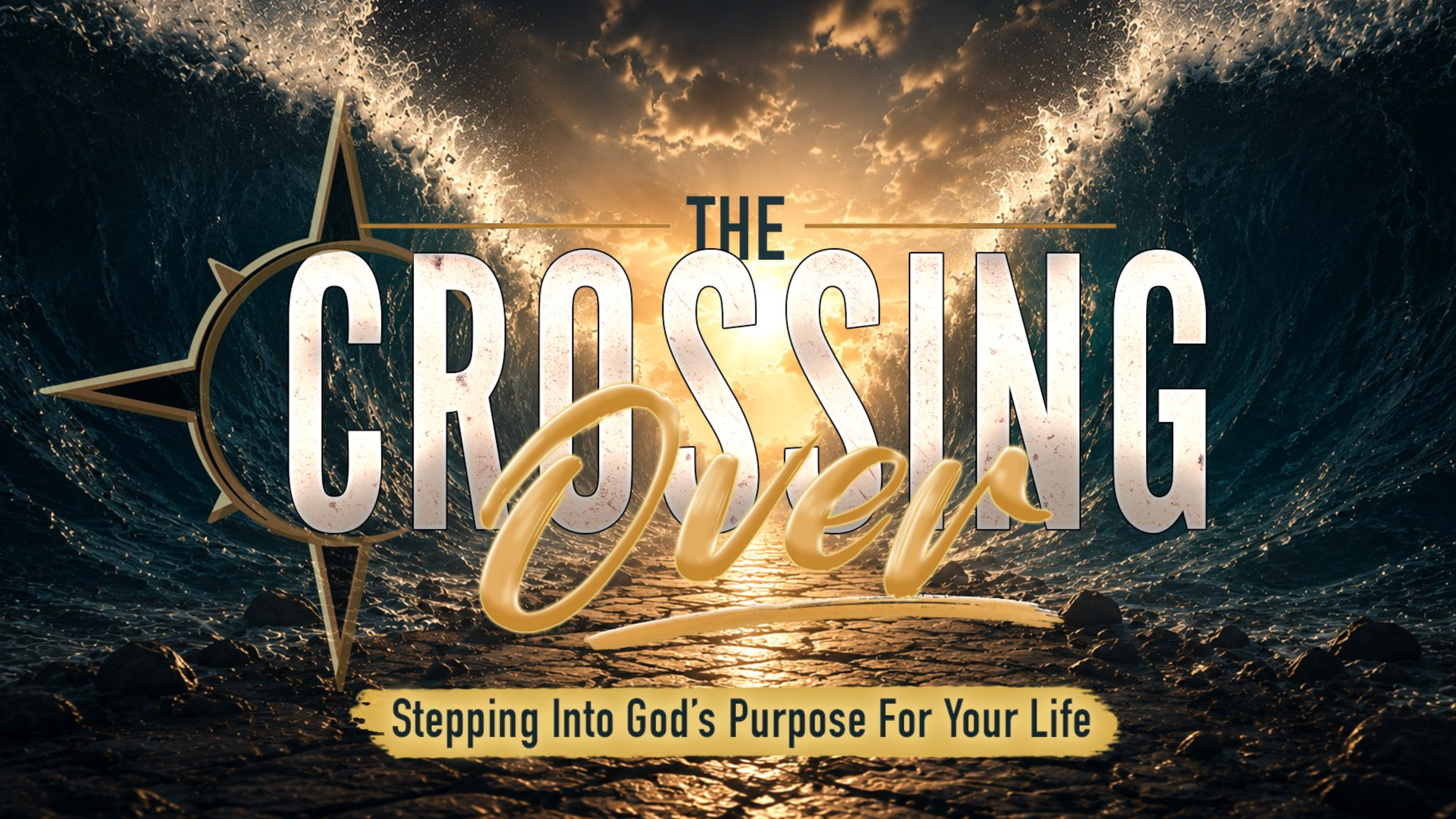

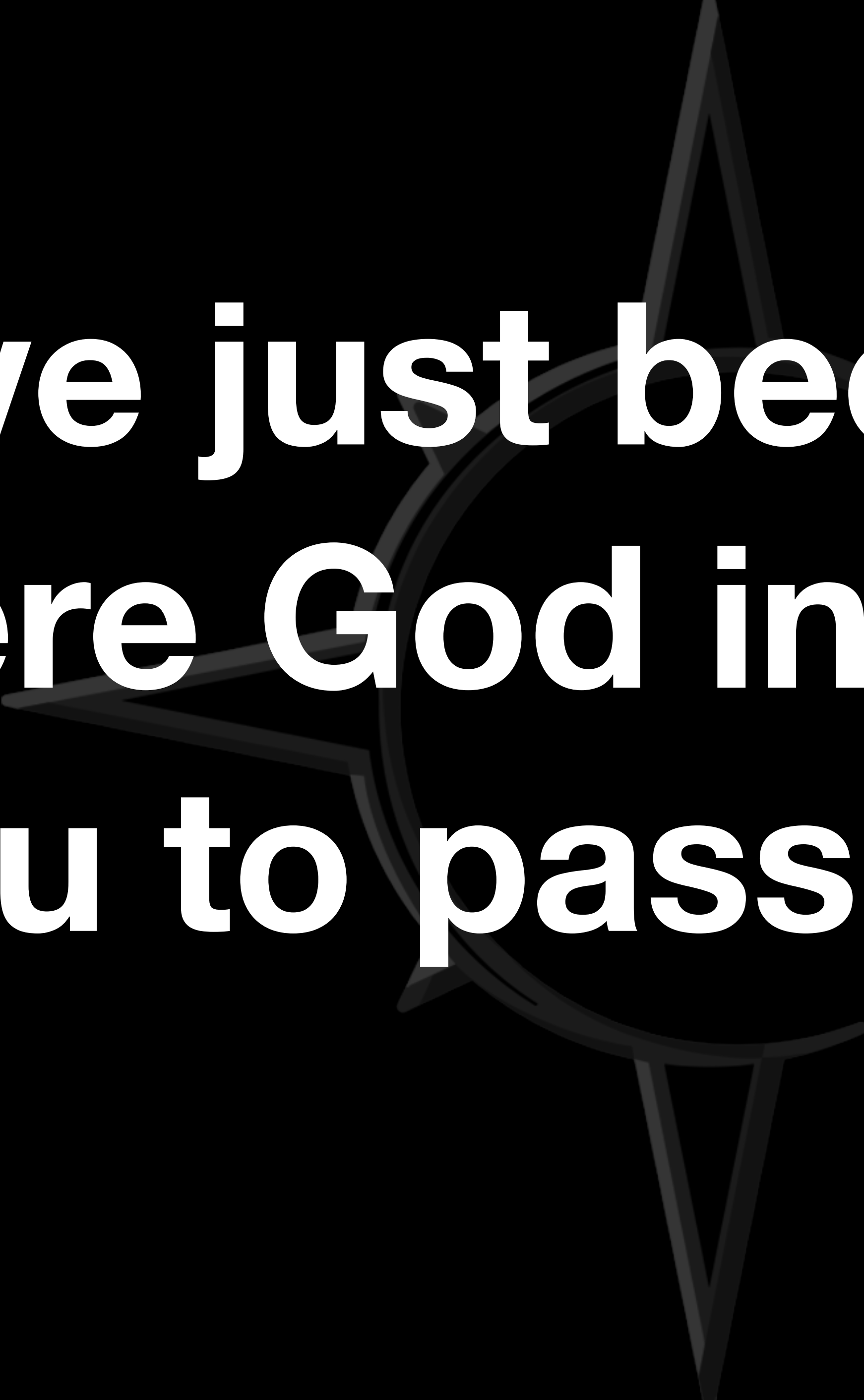

Numbers 13:33

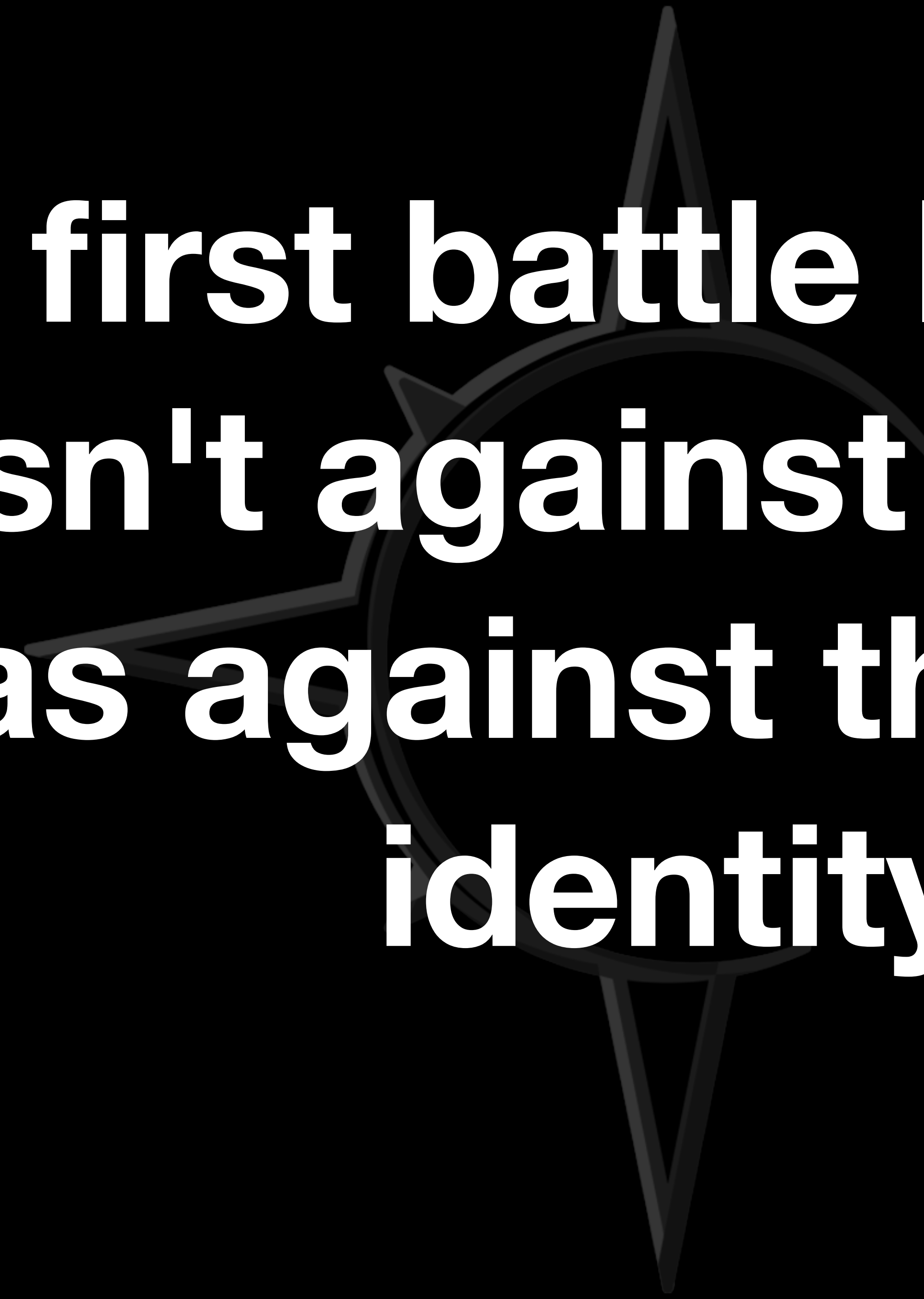
And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.



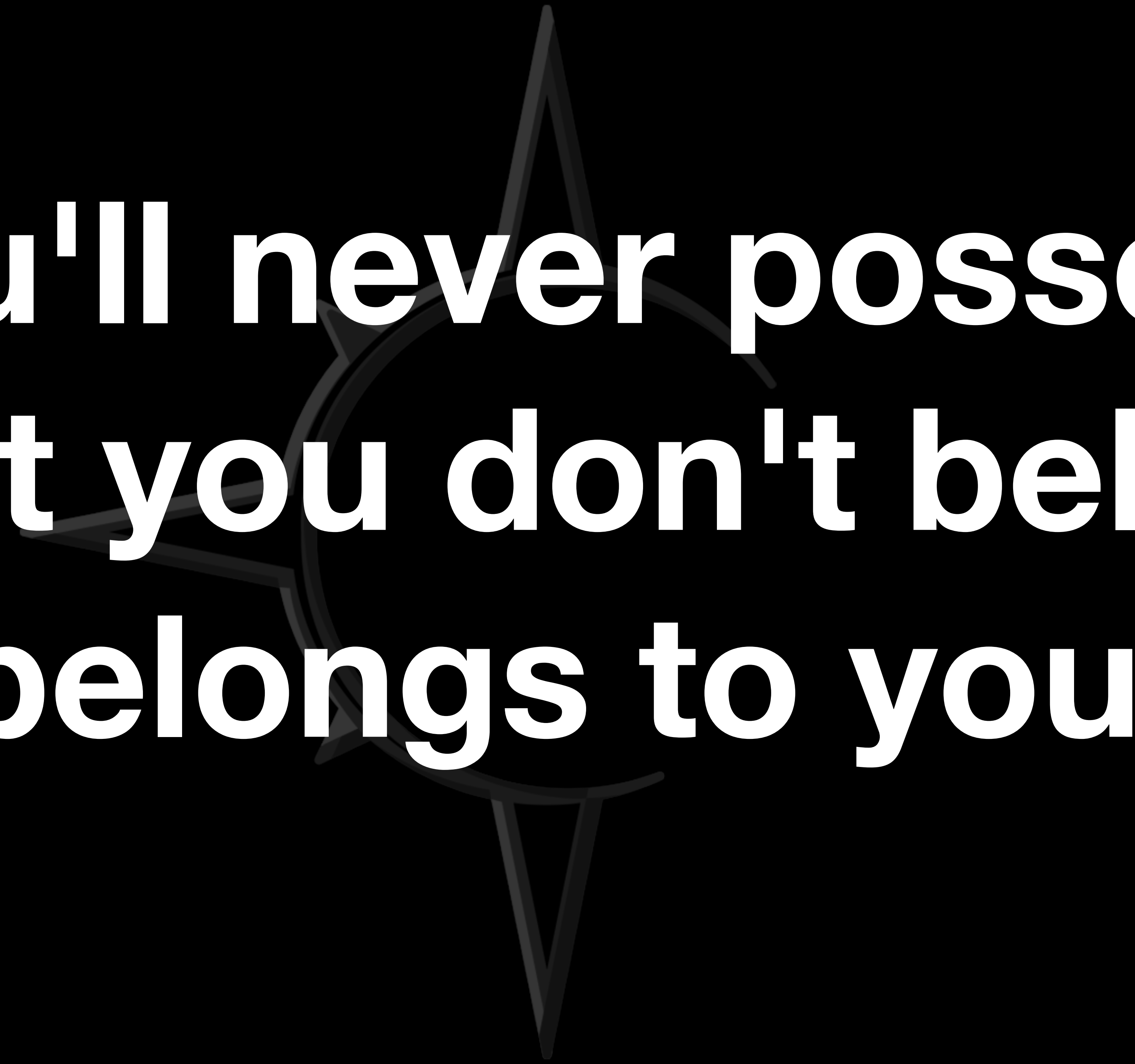

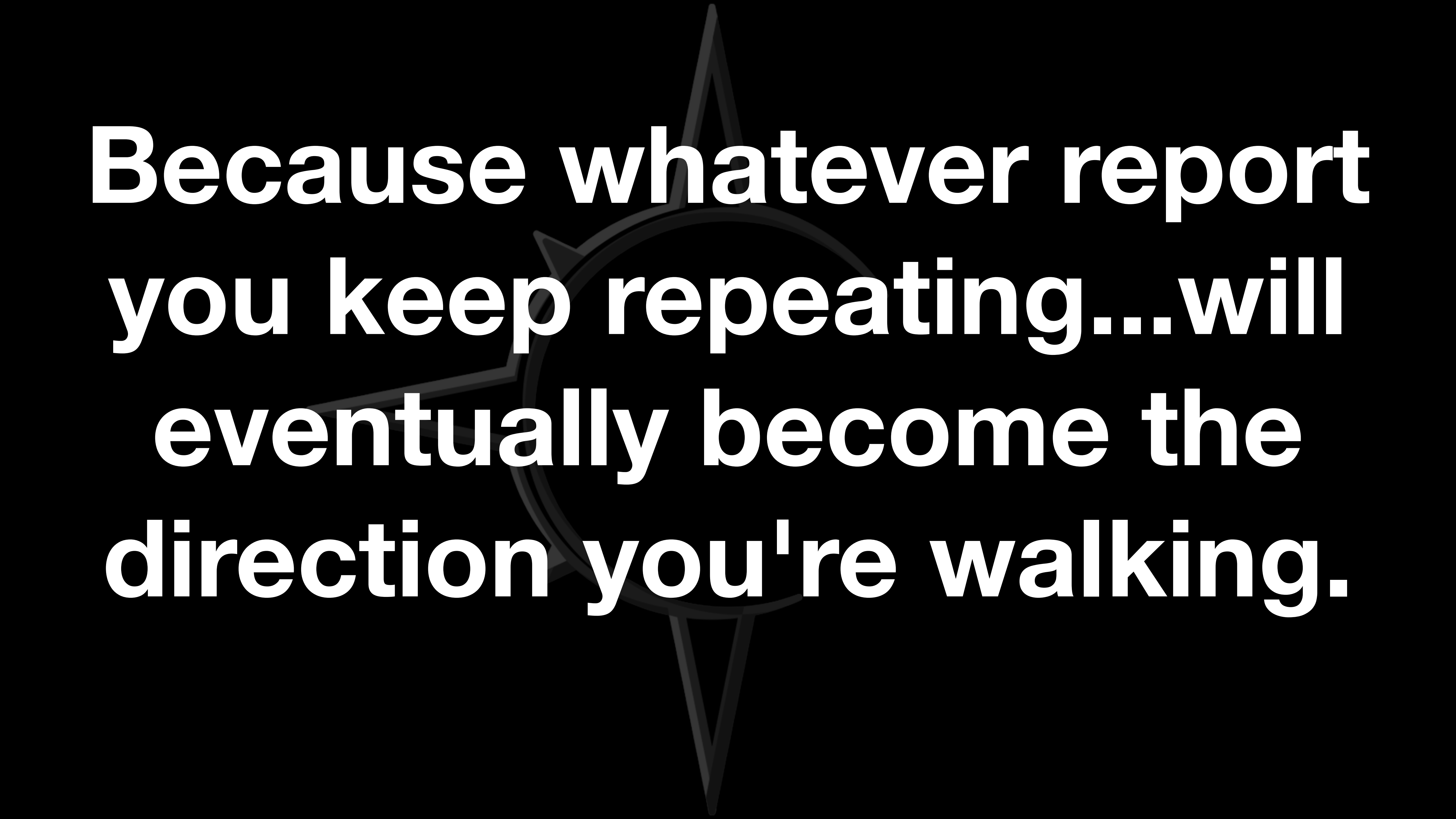

belongs to you.**



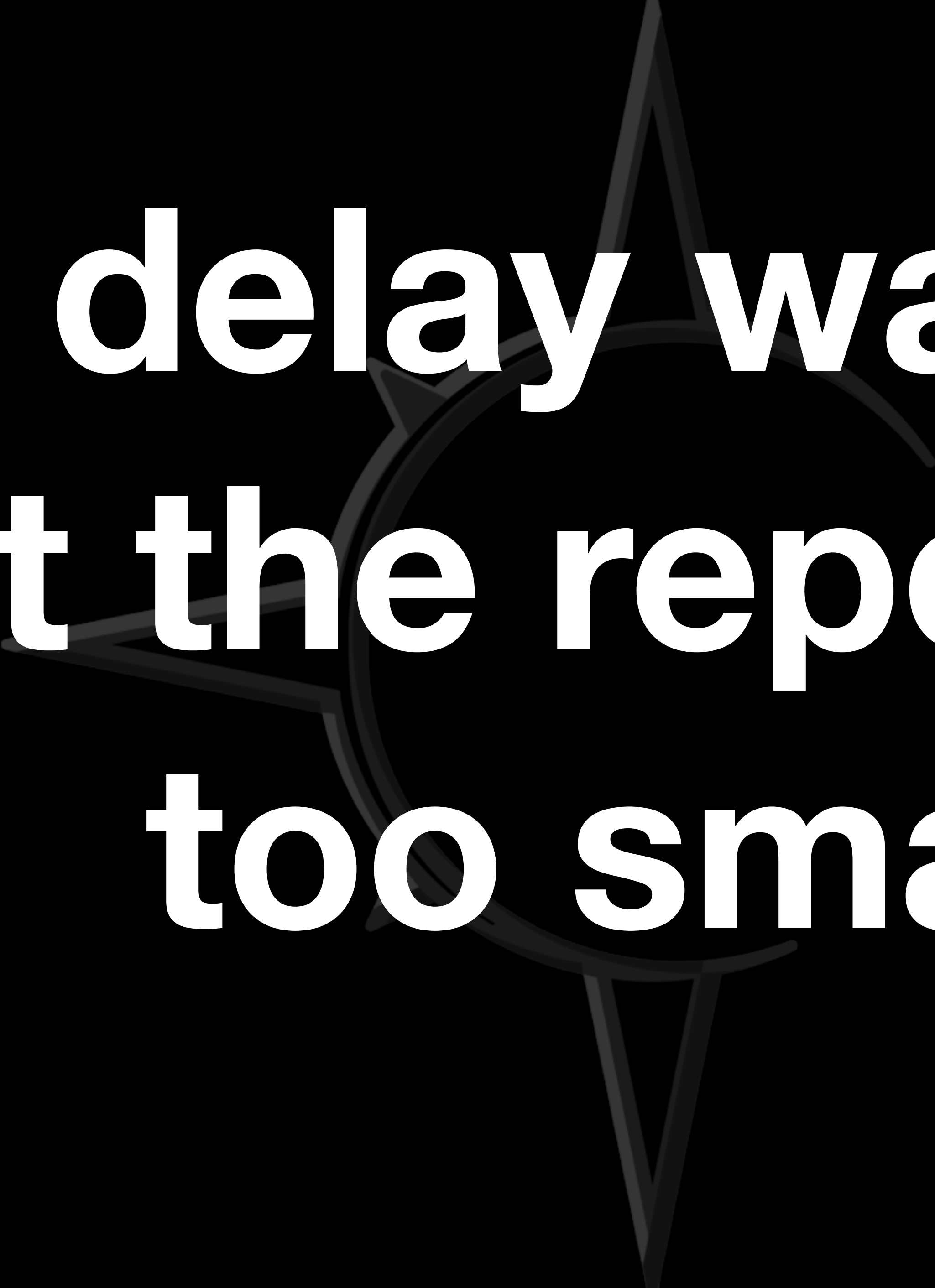

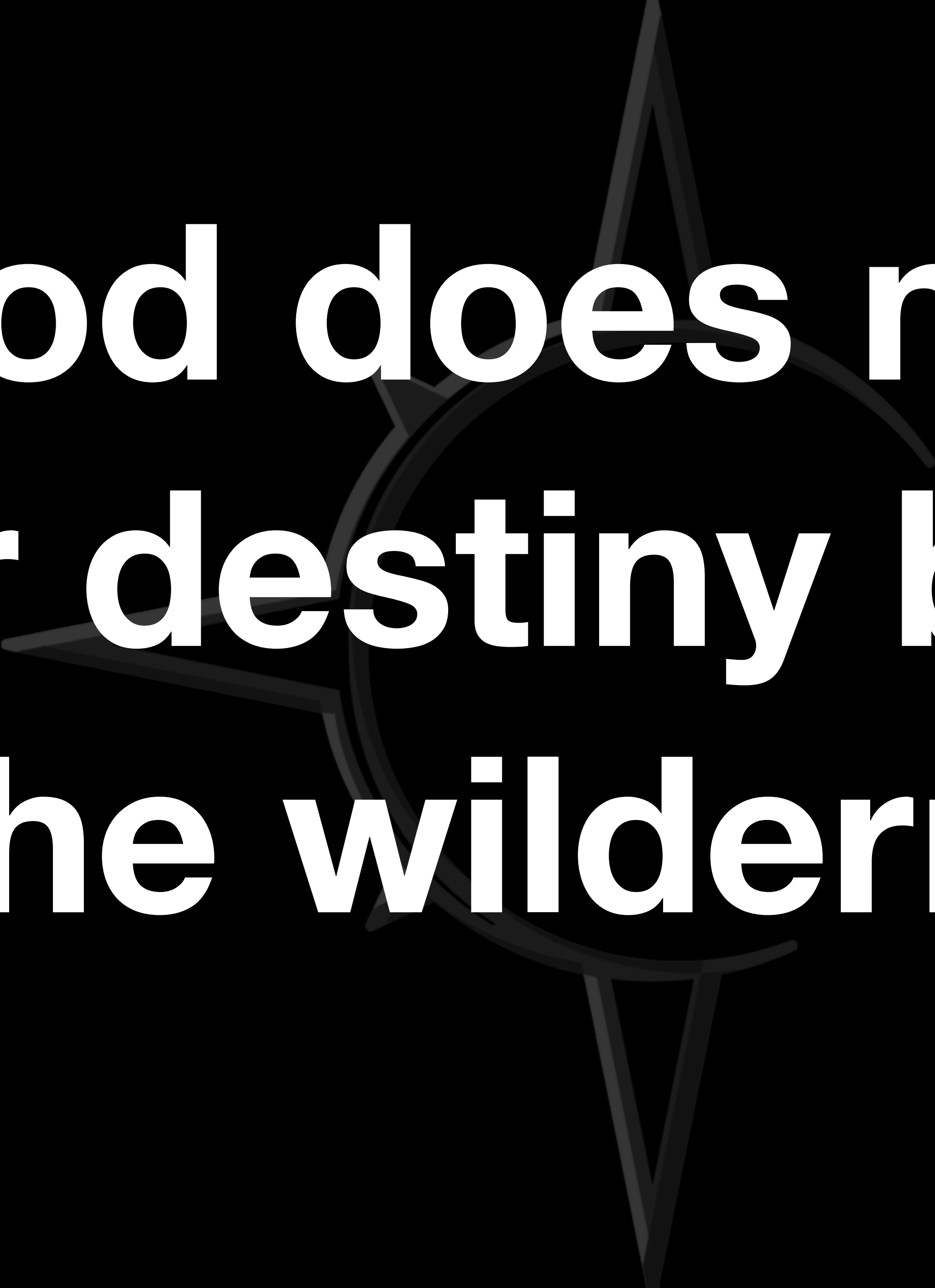

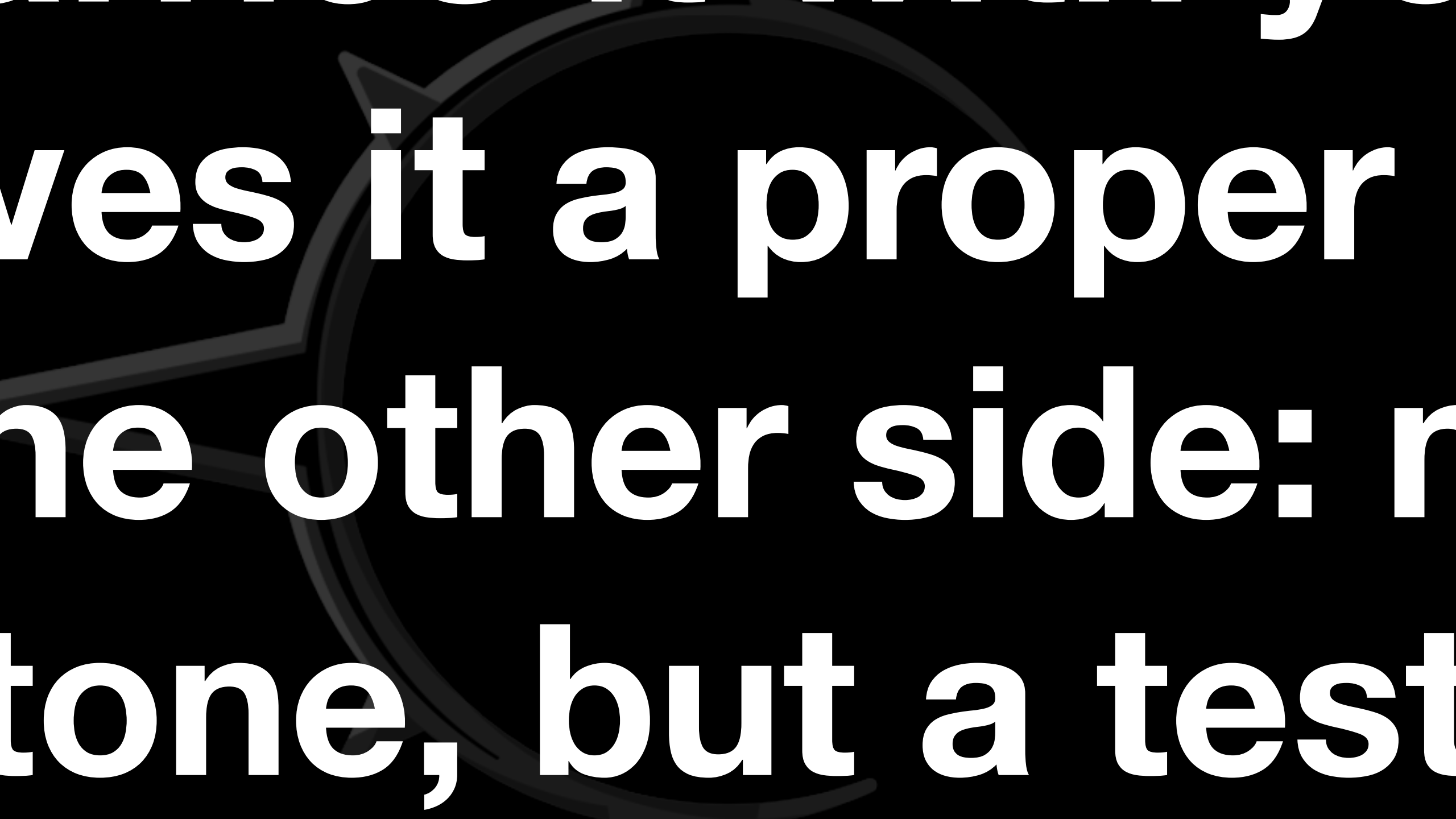

Ephesians 2:1 (paraphrased)

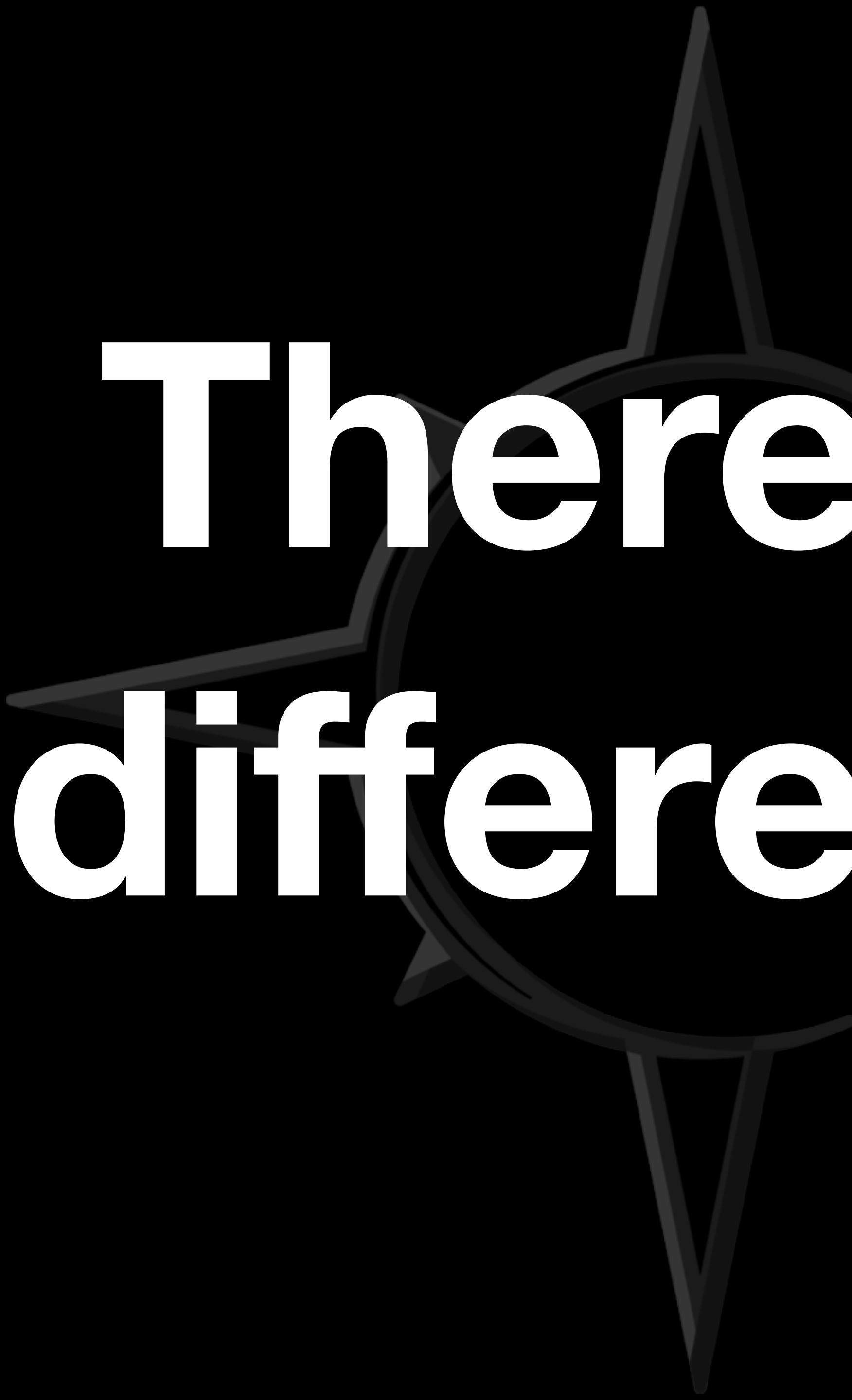
**We were dead in trespasses and

Joshua 3:15

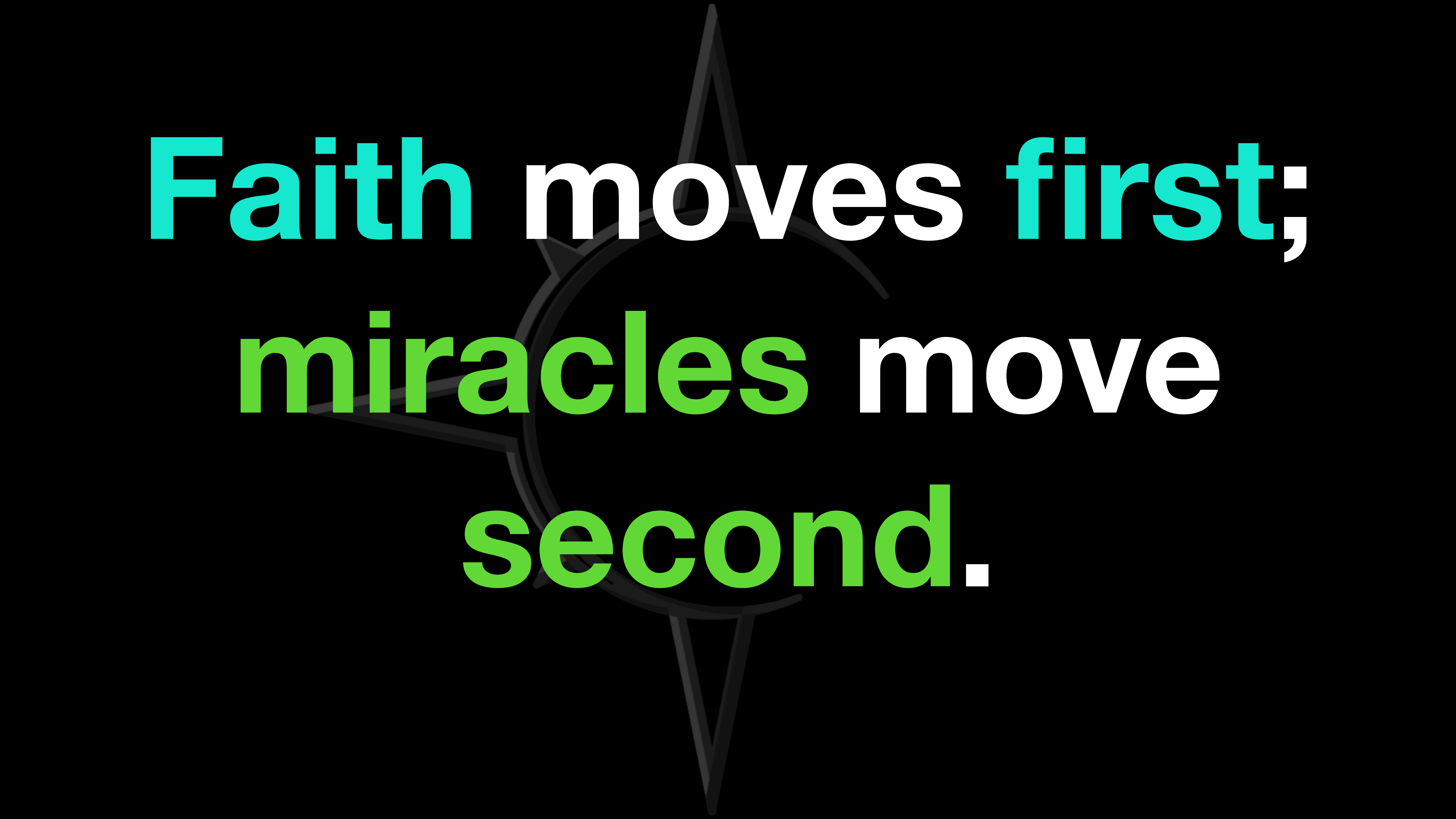
