Personal:

When he loses control, he is very disrespectful to the other boys at the foundation and the house parents, but he quickly calms down and tries to make things right.

-Second Grade



Education:

He is a very dedicated child. He likes math very much and he pays attention in class.

Family:

His parents have presented some difficulties living together, and this has been discussed with the family to improve these issues so they don't affect the child. His mother is very eager to learn new strategies in order to implement rules and boundaries at home.



Health:

He had a general doctor's appointment because hardly has an appetite. He was prescribed a purgative (to help cleanse his body of any parasites) and some blood tests. When the results come back, we will request an appointment for the doctor to review the results.

Spiritual:

He has a sensitive heart to hear from God and he enjoys learning new things.





Personal:

He likes to take care of animals and spend time with his friends, but he is often impulsive and wants to solve problems with fights. When he makes a mistake, it's easier for him to ask for forgiveness, and this used to be very difficult for him.

Education:

Mateo has been struggling in school, and on some occasions, he hasn't been participating in school activities. He has regular appointments with a psychologist and a psychiatrist to help him improve, due to the child's family situation

Family:

His mother shows concern and interest in his process, although it's difficult for her to fully understand the strategies provided by the foundation to implement rules and limits at home; she constantly relies on her sister who works and spends most of the day away from home.



Health:

We are currently waiting for him to be transferred over to Sisbén (health care provided by the state) for him to have appointments close by. He was hospitalized in the Mental Hospital of Antioquia, due to a psychiatric crisis that he presented; currently we are waiting for EPS SAVIA SALUD (health insurance) authorizations for treatment and psychiatric control appointments.

Spiritual:

Mateo has grown a lot in prayer, he enjoys praying and reading the Bible on his own.





Personal:

Mateo went through a personal crisis due a family situation, but he is gradually coming out of this situation with professional care and with the house parents' support
