God is Sovereign

He is our **SUPREME KING OF KINGS**

He has SUPREME AUTHORITY - Revelation 21:6

He is the CREATOR OF ALL THINGS - Colossians 1:16

He is OMNISCIENT – All Knowing – Romans 11:33

He is OMNIPRESENT - Revelation 21:6

He is OMNIPOTENT – All Powerful – Jeremiah 32:17

He is ETERNAL & IMMORTAL

HE rules in LOVE

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

God is the author of peace and joy.

"I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John 16:33 (NIV)

Your Sovereign God has good plans for you ... A specific path for your life.

He will not force you to follow his plan

He has given you and me free will...freedom to choose.

- It is his perfect plan for you to have have peace and joy
 - He is totally trustworthy in his love and plan for you.

He doesn't force you to trust him.

"When you don't have peace, look for where the evil one is at work."

In the midst of your storm:

God is still Sovereign.

God is still ALL KNOWING, and ALL POWERFUL. God is still LOVING

Your storm does not change God.

In every storm you have **CHOICES** to make when you don't have peace and joy.

1. STOP and IDENTIFY where Satan is at work

- 6. **ALLOW** His Joy and Peace to flood over you.
