Acts 22:14-21

God's Choosing

Verse 14 - What took place for Paul that revealed His choosing as an apostle? How does this differentiate Paul and the other apostles from the rest of the church? How does this help us see our similarity to Paul? (Eph 1:4; Gal 1:15)

Which group is Paul included in by this appointing/Choosing of God? By His seeing Jesus?

Why then should we be mindful of this in our study and life as Christians?
(1 John 1:1-3)

Verse 15 - What stands out here about the word "everyone"? Is this true for us?

Verse 16 - What does this verse remind us of regarding baptism? What does baptism do according to this verse?

What does the phrase "calling on His name" remind us of? (Joel 2:32)

- - Remember Paul is still using his own story rhetorically, restating the words of Ananias - -

Verse 17-18 - What is he up to here? A trance?

What does this trance mean? (Acts 10:10; 13:2; 2 Cor 12:2-4) Divine revelation.

Verses 19-21 - Is he making excuses or explaining his leaving of Jerusalem? Does Paul think He has enough credibility with the Jews to stay? Why would he want to sort of argue with Jesus about this? (Rom 9:1-3)

Who makes the final decision? How does this apply to us still today?
