Head Questions: (Thinking)

Think about this pattern of metaphors and how serious and intense the language is: **cleaning the land** (Deuteronomy 7), **crucifying the flesh** (Galatians 5:24), **dying to self** (Romans 12:1)... Now read Colossians 3:1-10... what causes us to put these things mentioned to death? (Hint: the answer is in verse 1)

Heart Question: (Stirring)

Have you experienced God's deliverance? What are some sins God has delivered you from that you would like to thank Him for?

Paul Washer made the comment, "God told Israel, '**You will be my people and I will be your God.**' to which Israel responded, 'Yeah and....????'" What is an area in your life in which you are having a hard time letting God be enough?

Hand question: (Moving)


We are commanded to love one another, how does unconfessed, unaddressed, or even private sin affect others? (Hebrews 12:1, Ephesians 4:16)

As you think of **running the race**, free and not snared, what do the next few days look like as you live sent in Faith, Hope and Love... towards your family, friends, and others in your circle of influence?
