The Evidence That I Have a "Saving" Faith Is That I Am
In The Process of Transformation

Definitions:

Faith: a Lifestyle <u>Trusting</u> God and Obeying Him Works: a Lifestyle of <u>Giving</u> Myself <u>Away</u> to God and Others

A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

4 Illustrations of the Evidence of Real Faith

The Needy

"If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that?" *James 2:15–16, ESV*

Anyone Can Be Moved To Tears, But Those Who Those Who Live By Faith Will Do Something about It

Those Who Live by Faith Will Grieve Over Their Sin

Demons

"You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons believe—and shudder!" James 2:19, ESV

Those Who Live by Faith Apply the Word of God to Real Life Situations

Abraham and Isaac

"Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up his son Isaac on the altar? You see that faith was active along with his works, and faith was completed by his works; and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"—and he was called a friend of God. You see that a person is justified by works and not by faith alone." *James 2:21–24, ESV*

When Those Who Live by Faith Reach a Dead End They Know God Will Provide

Rahab the Prostitute

"And in the same way was not also Rahab the prostitute justified by works when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way?" *James 2:25, ESV*
