Persevering Glad Hearted Faith in God Requires Patience

Christians Ought to Be the Most Patient People in The World. Not Because of Who We Are but Because of Whose We Are

I Can Be Patient Because...

I Know What's Coming

"Be patient, therefore, brothers, until the coming of the Lord. 5:7a, ESV

"Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
