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Revelation 2:12 - "To the angel of the church in Pergamum write: These are the words of him who has the sharp, double-edged sword."

Revelation 1:16: "In his right hand he held seven stars, and coming out of his mouth was a sharp, double-edged sword. His face was like the sun shining in all its brilliance."

Ephesians 6:17: "Accept God's salvation as your helmet and take the sword of the Spirit which is the word of God."

Hebrews 4:12: "For the word of God is alive and active - Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; It judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart."

Revelation 2:13-17: 13 I know where you live—where Satan has his throne. Yet you remain true to my name. You did not renounce your faith in me, not even in the days of Antipas, my faithful witness, who was put to death in your city—where Satan lives. 14 Nevertheless, I have a few things against you: There are some among you who hold to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to entice the Israelites to sin so that they ate food sacrificed to idols and committed sexual immorality. 15 Likewise, you also have those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans.
