Through oppression, misery and sor-  
row,  
30 He pours contempt upon princes,  
And makes them wander in a pathless  
waste, *Job 24:21; Deut. 32:10*  
41 But He sets the solitary on high  
away from affliction, *1 Sam. 2:8*  
And makes families like a flock.  
The upright see it, and are glad;  
all the righteous shut their  
mouths. *Job 5:10; 11:11; 16:19*  
Who is wise? Let him give heed to  
these things. *Jer. 9:12; 11:17*
